The new Highland Park City Hall has been built for a growing city both from the standpoint of population and architecture. While today the building stands in its own surroundings must some day change when varied trees and ravines. With a far more progressive building of semi-monumental character has been built for a metropolis. The plan of the building provides for a capacity will more than double the capacity of the old building.

The exterior of the building is of moderate face Wisconsin Lime Stone with Bedfordshire. The architectural town halls of many of the smaller American cities. The building is entirely fireproof, being built of reinforced concrete.

Through the main doorway we enter a circular lobby of Travertine Marble and with doors leading to the Police Department, Park Board Department and Park Board Department have independent entrances. The lobby includes a modern jail which equals the best in the country.

Directly across the circular lobby we ascend to a second lobby on the main floor which is surrounded by a colonnade where taxes and various assessments are paid. From here we enter the council chamber which is a large room. In this room the council meetings and public hearings are held. The council chamber is the Mayor's office and the City Municipal court and the Public Assessor's office. The public lobby by means of wide corridors is provided throughout the building as well as a large auditorium.

This building is one of two in this country which are veneered with Veneer Stone. Its soft blending colors are to be seen in the old public buildings in the New England States.

The interior of the building gives a favorable impression and amply houses the various departments of the city.
