

North Shore Musicians Preparing for Festival to Be Held May 19-24

Over twenty-five hundred residents of Evanston and its environs are devoting much time every week to rehearsals under the direction of Peter C. Lutkin and John W. Beattie for the twenty-second annual North Shore Festival to be held in Northwestern gymnasium during the week of May 19-24.

The number of voices in the chorus this year has been augmented by numbers of former members who are returning this year to take part in the founder's farewell festival. For nearly a quarter of a century Dean Lutkin has worked to bring to Evanston and the North Shore musical talent of national fame, he has striven to develop in this vicinity choral bodies equal to the best in the country. He has succeeded in establishing here a Festival organization which is known from one end of the country to another. Having achieved his aim, Dean Lutkin retires. He will present his final concert Saturday evening, May 24.

In discussing the opening concert to be given May 19, Dean Lutkin had the following to say: "The opening concert of the Festival will be an epoch-marking event in the history of choral music. It is extremely doubtful if on any one occasion such an array of choral masterpieces has ever been presented on one program. Palestrina, Bach, Handel, Haydn, Beethoven, Menhelssohn, Brahms and Verdi will all be represented by their finest choruses."

Two members of the North Shore community appear as soloists on the opening night of the Festival. Madame Alvene Resseguie, whose singing is known to festival patrons and music lovers in and around Chicago, and William O'Connor, a resident of Evaston who is studying music here, both make their appearance May 19.

At her own request, Madame Schumann-Heink appears twice during the Festival week. She will sing at the opening concert and again on Saturday when she appears on the matinee program. Madame Schumann-Heink has made three previous visits to the North Shore Festivals. She sang at the first concert in 1909, and desired to pay honor to the founder by appearing on Dean Lutkin's farewell program.

Two other soloists are scheduled for the opening night: Frederic Baer, young New York baritone and Nanetto Guilford, prima donna of the Metropolitan Opera make their debuts to North Shore audiences.
