the floor and smoked while the squaw, although tired, cut the wood, went out in the cache after feeding the dogs, and brought forth some Caribou meat. From this she carved some steaks and we had a tough, but welcome supper.

They had a few good beaded moccasins finished. I traded them some Calico, some flashlights and my Arctic Zipper boots, which I bought in Highland Park a year ago. Fortunately I had them on the sled and they were stuck on them. They did not have an abundance of fur, but were glad I came as it saved them to make a trip into the village. The following morning they had breakfast consisting of pancakes which reminded me of chewing a piece of tire tubing, but had to give the cook a few compliments and express the desire of having all the other natives made as good pancakes as hers.

A great big smile covered her face and immediately filled my plate with a big stack of More Pancakes! I could not show my regrets, but finished them and after a good smoke departed back to the Tanana river for about 11 miles and cut across country at a place more convenient for short-cutting.

This is only one of my experiences and will tell you all about them when I see you. I have just received a wire from the firm saying business is very rushing and I have now been in Nenana, disposed my dogs for 25 Muskrat skins, but was unable to sell them. They are undesired at this time of year. I will be leaving Fairbanks to morrow on the train and will depart for Seattle on Saturday on S. S. Alaska.

**Correct Census Figures
For North Chicago, New
Report Showing 8,495**

First census figures giving North Chicago only 6,666 residents and causing a furore among the civic leaders in that community, were corrected last Thursday by Mrs. M. K. Northam, supervisor for the 3rd Illinois district to give North Chicago a population of 8,495. Mrs. Northam also announced the census for Lake Forest as 6,137.

County residents have been waiting expectantly for the Lake Forest figures and their announcement giving Lake Forest's 68 per cent gain was received with interest.

Mrs. Northam said that the census maps made out in Washington for North Chicago were read incorrectly and that the 6,666 figure was that part of North Chicago lying north of Eighteenth street in Waukegan township and did not include the part to the south in Shields township. The new figure gives North Chicago a gain of 2,656 for the 10 year period since the last census.

Would Honor Eielson's Name

Juneau, Alaska.—American Legionnaires have asked that the name Copper Mountain in McKingly National Park be changed to Mount Eielson in honor of the late Carl Ben Eielson, a Legionnaire, who first landed an airplane in the park. Eielson met death in Russia while on a flight of mercy.
