

INTERESTING DATA ON FORT SHERIDAN

Details of Army Post Units and Other Matters Furnished by Headquarters

Following is data on Fort Sheridan, furnished by the publicity bureau of the Six Corps area:

Garrisoned by 1253 officers and men of the Regular Army, with 599 animals and 48 motor vehicles.

Units stationed here are:

2d Battalion and Band, 3rd Field Artillery (Battery "D" and Combat Train now at Camp McCoy, Sparta, Wisconsin for summer training) 8-75 mm guns, 374 officers and men, 187 animals.

1st Squadron, 14th Cavalry, 194 officers and men, 196 animals, 166 sabers, 12 machine rifles, 183 rifles and 194 pistols.

1st Battalion 2d Infantry, 287 officers and men, 50 animals, 229 rifles, 8 machine guns, 24 automatic rifles and 110 pistols.

61st Coast Artillery Anti-aircraft will arrive for station here on June 13 (at present enroute from Fortress Monroe, Virginia) 308 officers and men, 4-3 inch anti-aircraft guns, 16 anti-aircraft Caliber 50 machine guns, 6 search lights, 6 listening devices, 72 motor vehicles and 6 trailers.

Also Quartermaster Corps (with 58 civilian employes), Finance Department, Ordnance Department, Medical Department (with 11 Army nurses), and Signal Corps personnel.

Prepared to Take Field

The mission of the first four units

is to be prepared to take the field for extended field service at any time without previous warning; and also to train those portions of the National Guard, Organized Reserves, members of the Reserve Officers Training Corps, and students of the Citizens Military Training camps ordered to this post and to Camp McCoy for training.

This year a large number of National Guard and Reserve units, and R. O. T. C. and C. M. T. C. students will be trained at Camp McCoy by the 2d Battalion, 3rd Field Artillery.

At Fort Sheridan 2100 C. M. T. C. students will be organized into a regiment of six rifle companies, one machine gun company and two Cavalry rifle troops and a band, and drum and bugle corps. They will arrive on July 31 and leave on August 29: 350 R. O. T. C. students will train here from June 20 to July 31, and 597 Reserve officers, of many different units, will train here from June 15 to August 30.

Prepare for Tournament

In addition the garrison is now training for the Military Tournament and Exposition to be held at Soldiers Field from June 21 to 29 inclusive. This tournament will require the services of troops of this post, Fort Wayne Michigan (garrisoned by Headquarters 2d Infantry and 2 Battalion); Jefferson Barracks, Missouri (6th Inf.) Selfridge Fields, Michigan, Scott Field, Bellville, Illinois, and Chanute Field, Rantoul, Illinois, (1st, 17th, 27th and 94th Pursuit Squadron, 15th Observation Squadron, 5th Photo Section; Air Corps Technical school; 21st Airship Group, 8th, 9th Airship Co's, 21st Photo Section, A.

C.); all patriotic societies, and members of all foreign nationalities represented in Chicago, (the letter under direction of consuls of their respective governments stationed in Chicago).

Talcott Reappointed Waukegan Postmaster

Postmaster Mancel Talcott has been re-appointed by President Hoover to a third consecutive term as head of Waukegan post office, it has been announced from Washington. He

has already served in this capacity for eight years and will now continue for four more years, providing the senate approves the president's appointment.

During Talcott's career as postmaster of the city, business at the postoffice has tripled and it is through his efforts that the government decided to erect a new federal building in Waukegan.

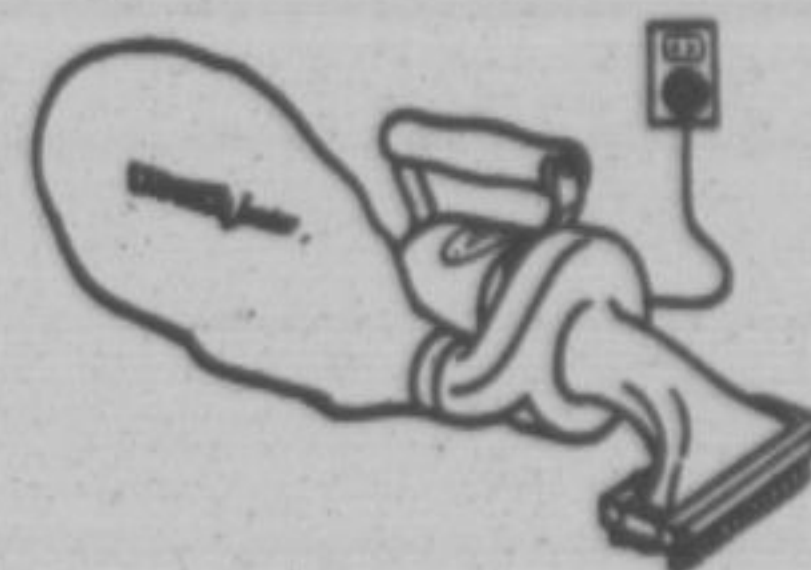

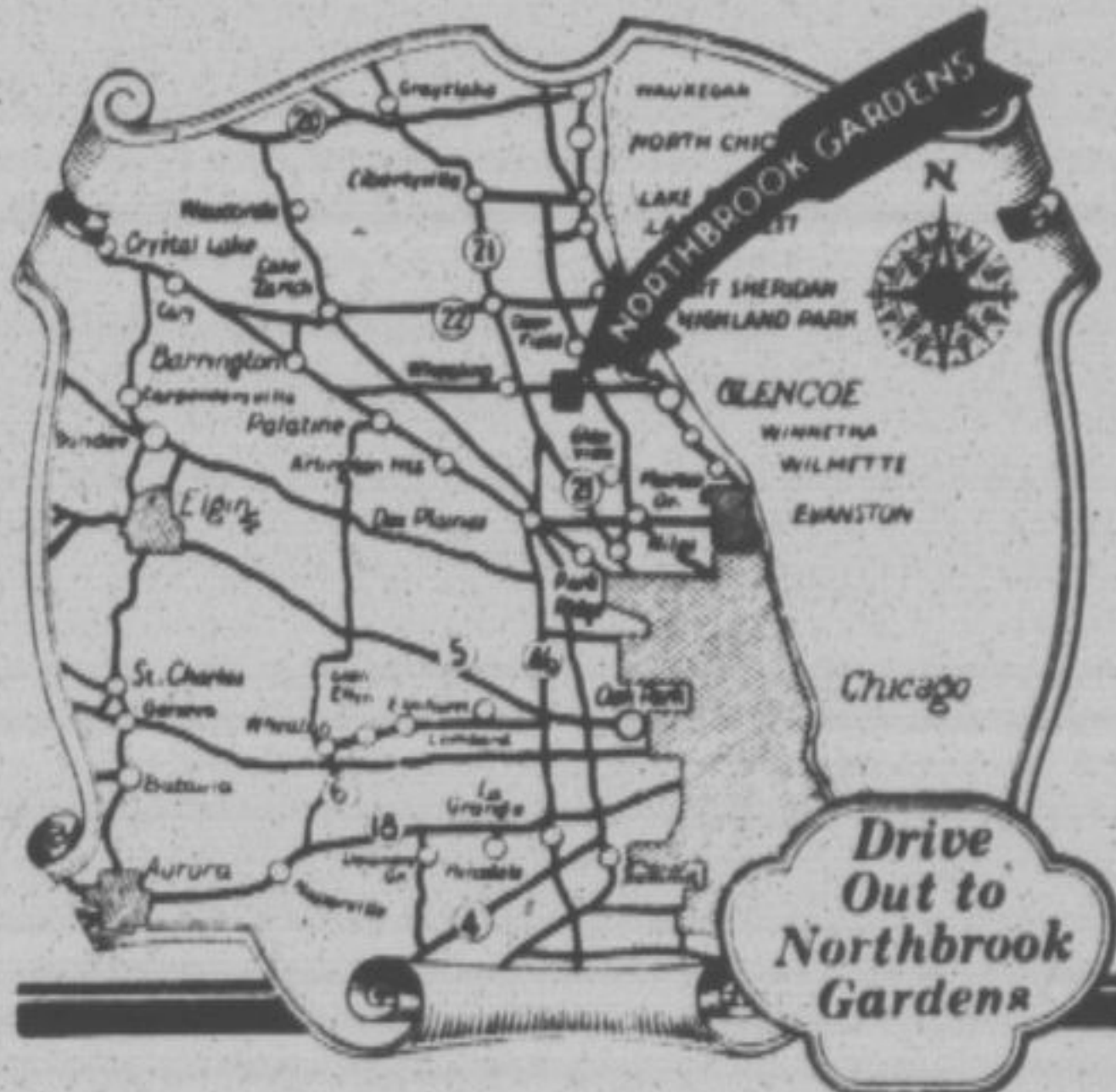
