BRIEF NEWS ITEMS FROM LAKE COUNTY

Interesting Events in This Part of North Shore; County Seat

Rear Admiral Walter S. Crosley, commandant of Great Lakes Naval Training station, has accepted the invitation to give the principal address at the dedication of the new municipal airport at Elgin on June 10. It was announced last week.

M. E. Wilson, who has served as football coach at the Elgin High school for the past several years, has been named head football coach at the Waukegan Township High school for the 1930-31 season, it was announced following a meeting of the board of education last week at Waukegan.

Early action on the selection of a site for the proposed Waukegan post-office building was assured by Congressman Carl R. Chindblom, in a message to members of the postoffice committee of the Waukegan and North Chicago chamber of commerce.

Mansfield, Ohio, which according to census returns is the twin of Wau-

kegan, both cities being reported as having 33,434 citizens, has accepted the challenge of the Waukegan and North Chicago chamber of commerce for contests in growth over the period of the next 10 years.

President R. F. Rouse of the Mundelein village board last week re-appointed the various village offices now serving and their names were confirmed by the board members. Clayton Tiffany was re-named chief of police, Gladys Dolth, village treasurer and John Deitz, water inspector.

John P. Kottcamp, general manager of the Waukegan plant of the Johns-Manville corporation, was last week elected president of the Waukegan Rotary club.

Charles Albright, of Grayslake, died last week at the Lake County general hospital of injuries received when a car in which he was riding turned turtle in a ditch near Grayslake. A broken neck is believed to have caused his death.

Lake County Bar Assn. Adopts Rules and Fees at Meeting Last Week
