

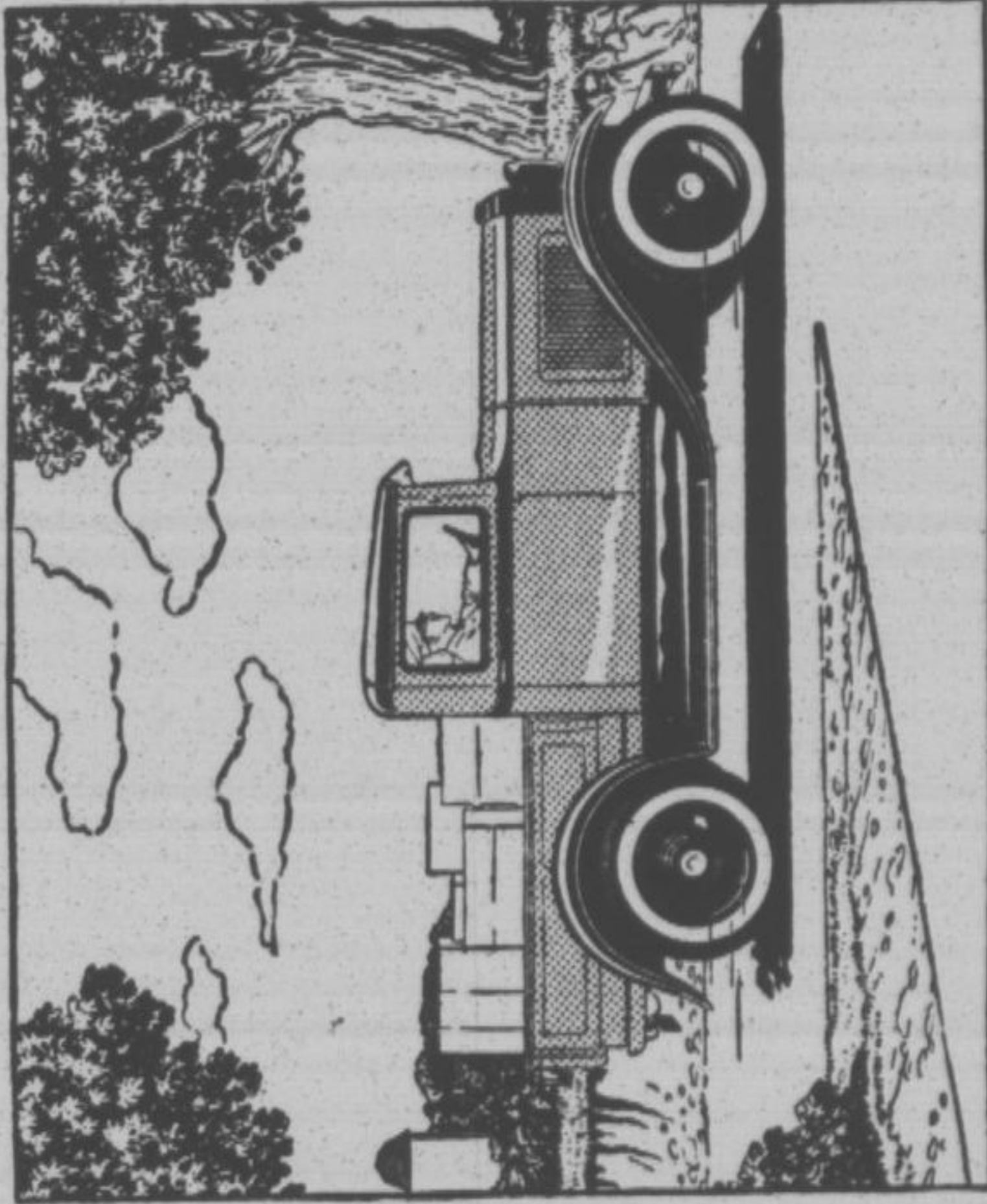

**Census Gives County Nearly 100,000 With Two Districts Not In**

Lake county had almost reached the 100,000 mark in population this week when the report for Shields township outside of cities and village added another 9,422 to the total.

Mr. M. K. Northam, of Evanston, census director for the district, stated that the Shields township figures for the rural district had dropped considerably from the 1920 report which showed a population of 12,731. This was due, she stated, to the fact that Lake Forest had annexed a large territory to the west.

With the reporting of Shields township there were but two sections of Lake county that are unheard from. Libertyville township outside of the village of Libertyville, is to be reported and also the city of Highland Park. Highland Park figures are expected Friday or Saturday.

Libertyville township in the rural section should have more than 1,000 people, it is believed, while the city of Highland Park will run 12,000 or in excess of that figure as there were more than 6,700 residents in 1920.

The total for the county, as near as can be estimated, will be about 115,000.

**Convicts to Be Given Better Clothing When Released from Prison**

Convicts released or paroled from the Illinois state penitentiary here will no longer be given poor fitting suits, bearing the "prison stamp" and high, uncomfortable shoes, it has been decided by Rodney Brandon, director of the department of public welfare, and Frank D. Whipp, state superintendent of prison.

For many years when a convict obtained a parole or release it has been the practice of the state to give the inmate a cheap suit of clothing. In many instances these suits did not fit the man properly and were soon discarded.

At a conference at Chester, Director Brandon ordered that clothing of better material be supplied for outgoing convicts. Neat oxfords will replace the high shoes and the clothing will be much better material.

"I am heartily in favor of the change that is being made," said Warden Henry C. Hill. "There is no reason why the state should parole or release a man from prison in clothing which the inmate is ashamed to wear."

No changes are contemplated in prison uniforms which are manufactured in the prison shops.
