In short the school will be a small community in the practice of Christian living.

The teachers are trained and especially fitted for their tasks. Miss Annie L. Cobb will direct the work of the kindergarten. Miss Cobb is a graduate of National Kindergarten college, has done graduate work in Teachers' college, and has conducted kindergartens in Highland Park and in Long Island. She will be assisted by Frances Jenkins, Eva Harris, and Louise Smith. Miss Ruth Hardiman, a student in National Kindergarten college and with several years of experience in the Vacation Church schools of Denver, Colorado, will direct the primary. Rose Alma Roth and Betty Ann Sheperd will assist

Miss Hardiman. Miss Gladys Greenlaw, director of religious education in the Presbyterian church, will direct the junior department, and supervise the school with the assistance of Elizabeth Morris and Willard Ericson. Rev. F. W. Fischer, pastor of the St. John's Evangelical church, will direct the Intermediate department. Willard Ericson will have special charge of the out of door activities and the handcraft for the older boys. Mr. Ericson has assisted with a scout troop the past winter and completed a course for leaders in scouting. Miss Louise Smith will have charge of the music for all departments and assist in the kindergarten. Miss Smith has taught in the beginners' department of the Church school for several years.

In order to do the best work possible the teachers and assistants will attend the training institutes on Saturday mornings and Monday afternoons conducted by the Chicago Federation of Churches. This together with their experiences and special training will add to the spiritual and educational value of the school. If parents desire further information, they may call Miss Greenlaw, H. 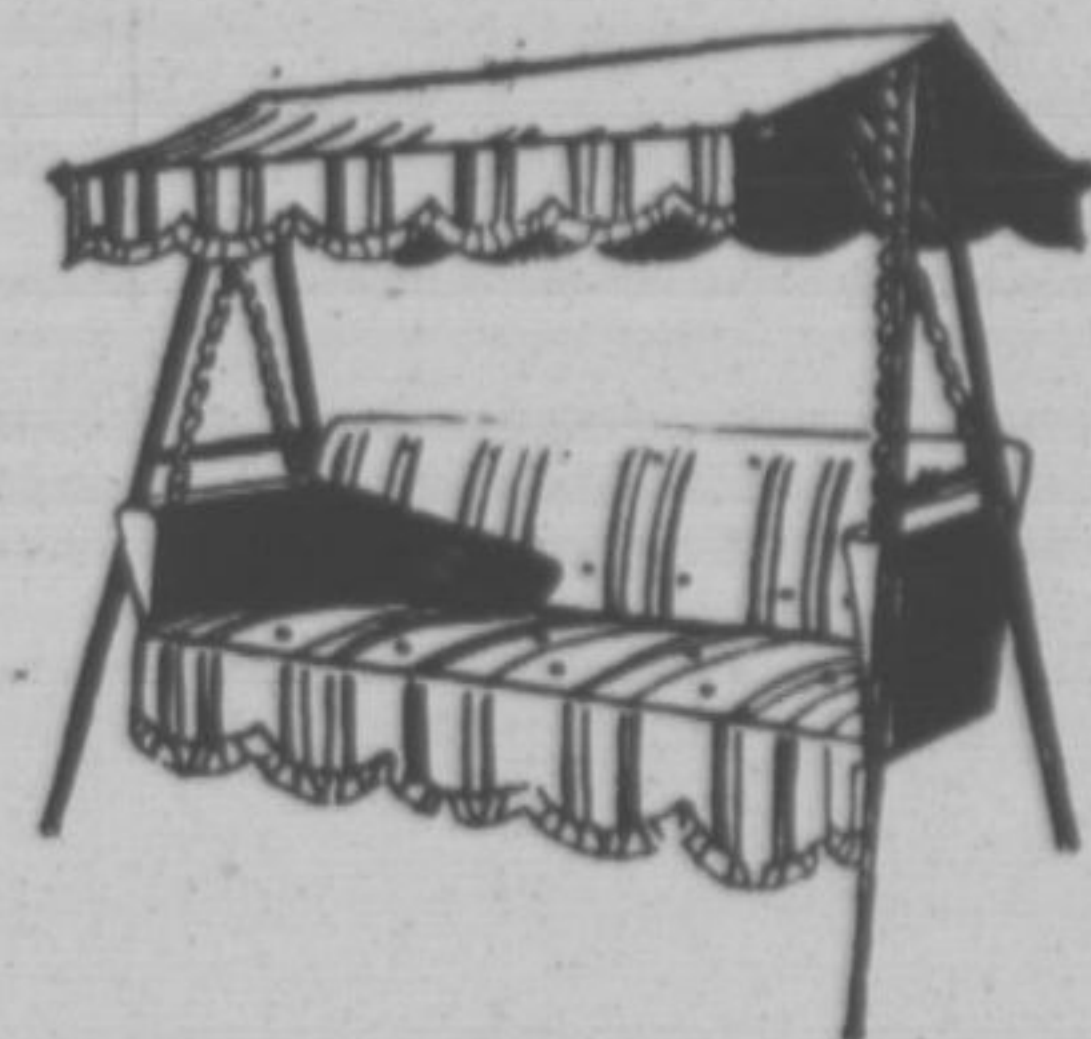
