**Unemployed in County
Total 1,812; Deerfield
Township Not Included**

The supposed vast army of unemployed in Lake county today dwindled to an actual 1,812 through the accurate figures released Saturday through Mrs. M. K. Northam, of Evanston, census supervisor for the third district, of which Lake county is a part.

This did not include the city of Highland Park and Deerfield township, because the figures for that city had not been disclosed.

Waukegan, so the report shows, has 1,035 out of work. The enumerators were advised to learn the number of able-bodied persons regularly employed who were out of work at the time the census was taken.

Is 1.5 Per Cent of Total

Those out of employment and seeking positions, number about 1.5 per cent of the estimated population of 120,000, which would include the city of Highland Park.

Waukegan township, which takes in a large part of North Chicago, has more than 60 per cent of all the unemployed.

The record by cities is as follows: Antioch 19, Grayslake 31, Hainesville 1, Round Lake 6, Winthrop Harbor 224, Zion 141, Deerfield 5, Highwood 259, Lake Forest 84, Lake Zurich 2, Mundelein 4, Fox Lake 17, Lake Villa 7, Libertyville 93, Lake Bluff 22, North Chicago 314, Gurnee 7, Wauconda 13, and Waukegan 1,035.

Record by Township

The record by township is as follows: Antioch 30, Avon 48, Benton 165, Cuba 28, Ela 5, Fremont 5, Grant 35, Lake Villa 18, Libertyville 101, Newport 9, Vernon 16, Warren 12, Wauconda 18, Waukegan 1,294 and West Deerfield 28.

The record, according to local men, is far better than any of the other Illinois districts and considered exceedingly favorable.
