

Plane Seized May Be Booze Runner; Often Seen Over Lake Co.

Discovery of a plane, believed to have been regularly engaged in smuggling liquor from Canada to Chicago in terminal hangar at the Chicago municipal airport by customs and prohibition agents is believed to be the first step by the government toward ferreting out the identity of pilots of these planes which pass over Lake county nightly in their trips.

Thousands of residents of Waukegan and North Chicago and other north shore towns have been awakened during the night by the roar of airplane motors. They usually pass over the north shore between the hours of 1 and 3 o'clock in the early morning. They follow the shore of the lake more closely than do the mail planes.

It has been generally understood for months that these planes are those engaged in the transportation of liquor from the border to Chicago. The pilots land in cut of the way airports or private landing fields, it is declared.

The plane found by the customs and prohibition agents contained a secret compartment capable of holding more than 20 cases of liquor. While it is considered doubtful that such a large amount was hauled in any one trip due to weight, it is believed that the plane served to bring in from 15 to 20 cases of whiskey on each trip.

Lawyers at Rockford to Boost Candidacy of Dady for Judge

Several attorneys espousing the candidacy of Attorney Ralph J. Dady for circuit judge, last week were in Rockford, where the lions share of the vote of Winnebago county is located, in the interest of the local candidate.

Among those visited there was Circuit Judge Arthur E. Fisher who was given unanimous support of the Lake county delegates when he was named circuit judge three years ago after the death of the late Earl D. Reynolds.

Those in the field as a successor to Attorney Claire C. Edwards are Attorney George W. Field, of Waukegan, and City Judge Theodore R. Forby, of Zion. Attorney Okel Fuqua, former assistant attorney general, has been mentioned as a dark horse in the event that Field and Dady deadlock.

The date of the caucus is indefinite but the election will be held in November at the general election, according to information reaching here from Gov. Louis L. Emmerson.
