"I can't say that I am interested to any great extent but Chicago offers the logical center for our federal court trials," he said.



> If the boiler door is badly warped or cracked, it should be replaced, since a door that is hard to close c. uses inconvenience and often results in the loss of draft as well as the inability to control the fire. Hinge pins should be examined carefully. Grates should be checked.

The mortar between the bricks of a chimney and around the smoke pipe often deteriorates to a point where it is completely eroded by the weath-

er. This condition causes a leakage and refuse should be taken from the of cold air into the chimney and often ash pit and firepot. interferes with proper draft.

If an inspection of the heating plant reveals excessive accumulation of flue dirt, this should be removed in the spring. If this is delayed until' the end of the summer, a thin layer of correded iron will peel off with the soot. Soot should be scraped from the smokepipe, and all ashes


