To Aid Schools in Teaching Geology of Illinois Is Purpose

The Illinois State Geological Survey this year is inaugurating a program, making available to the public schools of Illinois information concerning the geology of the state which has been discovered during the past 25 years of investigation, and which promises to become one of the most active and worthwhile educational undertakings, according to Dr. M. M. Leighton, chief of the Survey.

One of the most important phases of the program consists of six scheduled earth-history field trips for science teachers, to be conducted in various parts of the state each year and arranged for by the teachers themselves. The preparation and distribution of representative study and exhibition sets of the common rocks, minerals and fossils of the state to all high schools petitioning for them, in another important angle of this educational service. The sets will be accompanied by supplementary study manuals which will contain discussion of the various mineral resources which make Illinois rank ahead of 41 other states of the Union in value of production.

Mr. Don Carroll, a geologist of special university graduate training, has recently been added to the Geological Survey staff to give his attention to this work.

State Tourists Guide Points Out Points of Interest; Is of Value

The Tourist Guide of Illinois, being prepared by the publicity committee of the Illinois Chamber of Commerce and now being made ready for publication by H. L. Williamson, chairman, calls attention to the fact that nearly every city in Central Illinois has some land mark or building that marks the past presence of Lincoln. Lincoln's monument and tomb at Springfield, Old Salem, Metamora Court house, points in Greene county, the city of Lincoln and other places are mentioned. The historic background of Jacksonville is given together with the story of Fort Creve Coeur, old Fort Edwards near Warsaw, Winchester, old home of Stephen A. Douglas, Uncle Joe Cannon's home at Danville, etc. The Indian Mounds in Fulton county, quaint Bernadotte, Nauvoo and other points of more than ordinary interest are cited for the benefit of the traveler in Illinois.

The tourists' guide as prepared by the State Chamber has received the warm approval of Governor Emmerson. It has been collected through the co-operation of 27 newspaper editors, local chambers of commerce and individuals and will include a large number of photographs illustrating each particular section.
