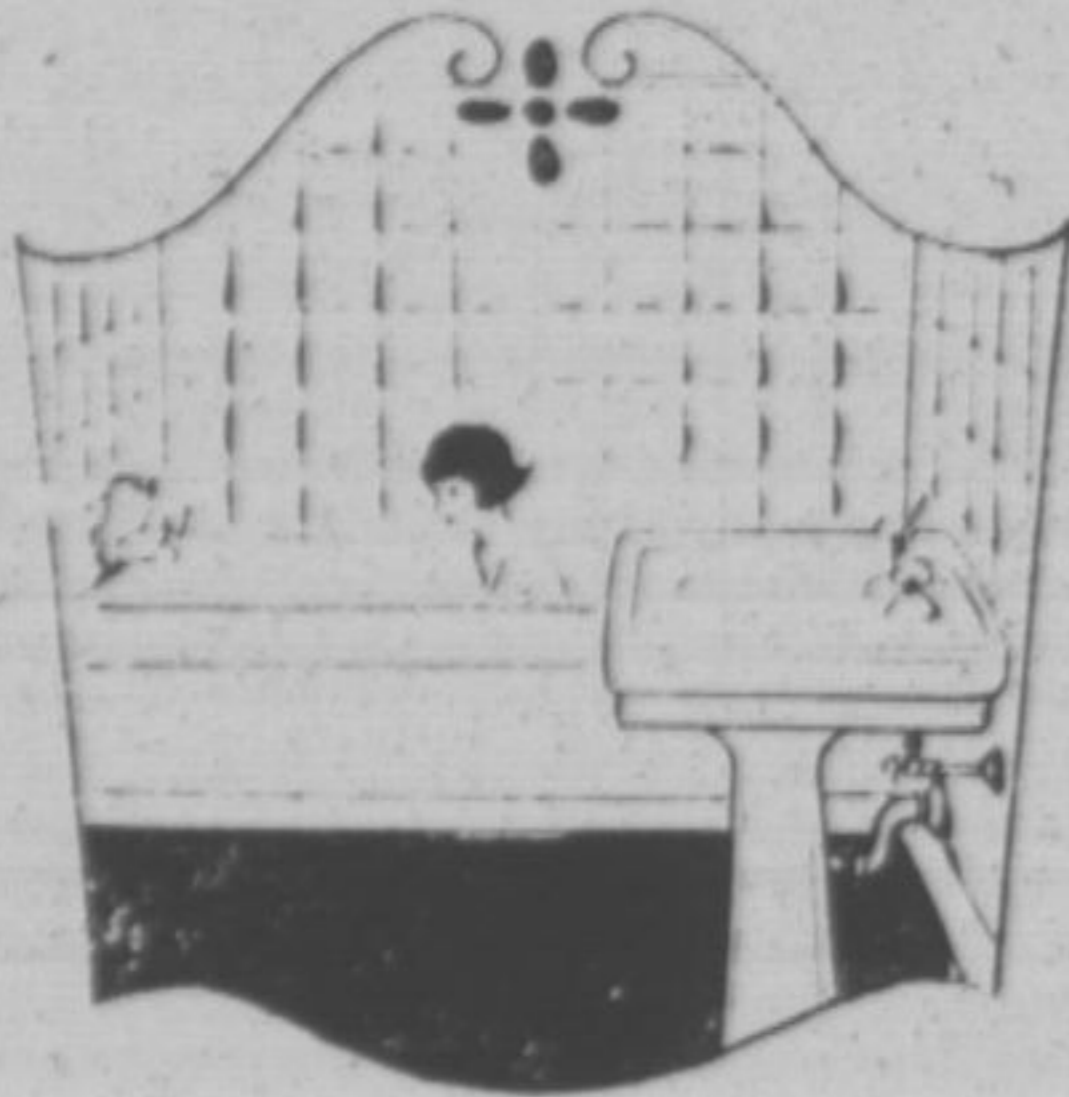

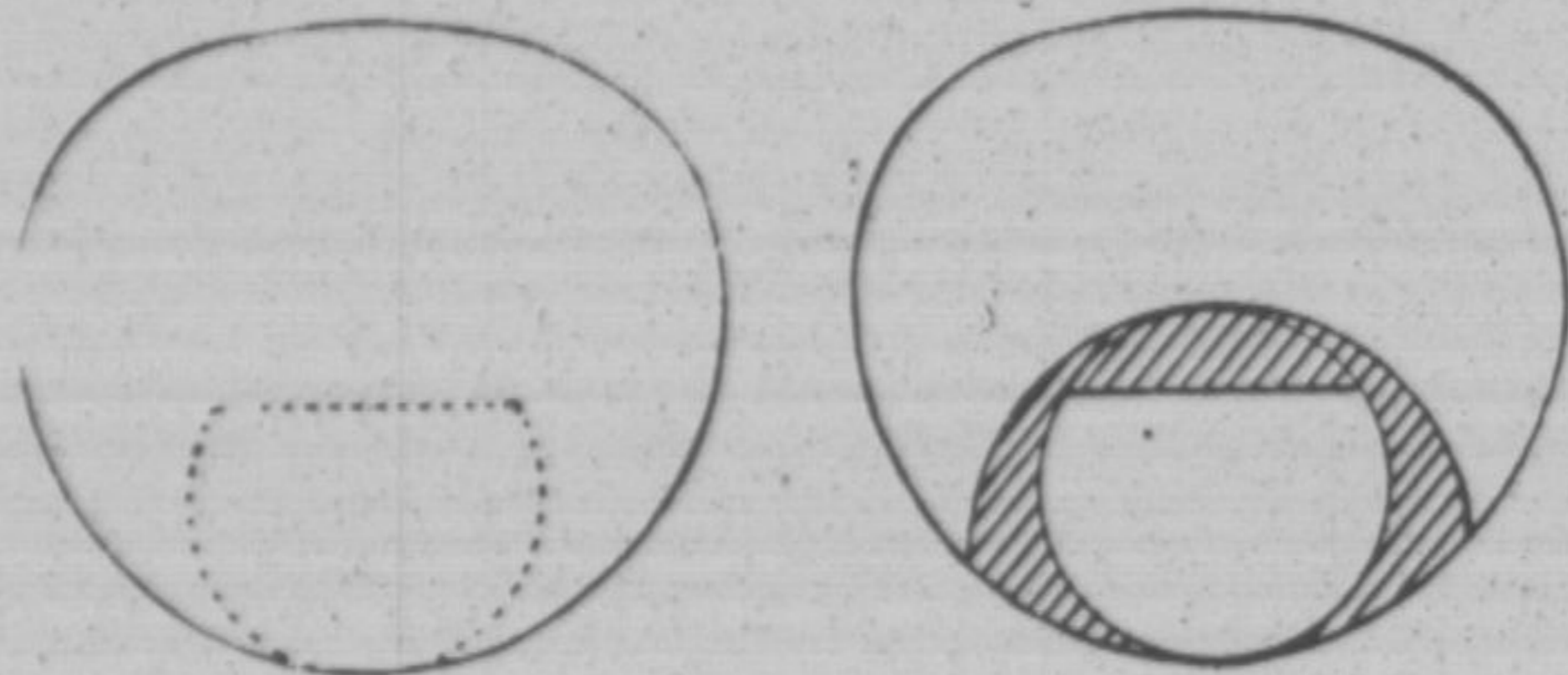

## RESERVE OFFICERS IN CAMP AT FORT

Annual R.O.T.C. Opened Friday  
and Continues Six Weeks;  
Officers in Charge

The sixth R.O.T.C. summer camp to be held at Fort Sheridan opened last Friday with an attendance of about 350 students, representing 19 different schools and colleges located in 11 different states. Coming from as far east as Cornell and as far south as Florida, the college men will once more undergo a six week's training season in their endeavor to qualify and gain commissions as second lieutenants in the reserve corps.

Preceded to the Fort by 30 officers of the regular army on duty with them at the various schools, the R. O. T. C. men will this year for the first time undergo a new feature in that they will be quartered in tents in the summer training camp area, occupying Black and Blocher streets, the first two nearest the lake.

## Bandits Rob Pharmacy at Waukegan of \$200

Two armed bandits, operating under bright lights and in full view of passing pedestrians, held up the North Avenue Pharmacy, 612 North avenue, Waukegan, last week and escaped with cash amounting to \$201.20.

The greater part of the money, \$128.20, was taken from the government postal substation in the store.

Irwin Walker, 914 Hickory street, was the only clerk in the store at the time of the robbery, 10:35 Wednesday night. The bandits locked him in a closet at the rear of the store while they emptied cash drawers, and made their escape through the back door into the alley.

Second street, narrowly escaped serious injury when their automobile, driven by Sullivan, turned over twice in a crash with a car driven by Arthur Johnson, chauffeur for A. K. Foreman of 1219 S. Sullivan and his wife were injured slightly, and were rushed to the Highland Park hospital, where they were given emergency treatment for slight cuts and bruises and released.
