British-U. S. Track Meet at Soldier's Field, August 27th

America's supremacy in the track and field sport which was seriously threatened in the Olympic games at Amsterdam in 1928 will be put to a still further test in the fourth renewal of the games between the British Empire and the United States to be held at Soldier's Field in Chicago, August 27th.

This meet, since its inception in 1920, has come to be regarded as the outstanding event of its kind in the world with the exception of the Olympic games. Both nations marshal their greatest track stars for the occasion and the resultant races provide competition of the highest order.

The first meet was held following the Olympic games of 1920 at London under the auspices of the Achilles club. The events consisted largely of relay races to promote the spirit of team competition and the scoring system used was to count one point for each event won. Under this system the meet resulted in a tie.

So successful was the meet that it was repeated following the Olympic games of 1924 and 1928, resulting in victory for the United States by scores of 11 to 3 and 8 to 6 respectively. Fourteen events are on the program, six of which are relay races.

May Bar Marriage of Mentally Incompetent in Illinois by Law

Marriage of those mentally incompetent may be taboo in Illinois following the next general assembly session.

The state department of public health is sponsoring legislation either for restriction or prevention of such marriages, it was learned today, the department is collecting data as to the result of these marriages and is planning to use these facts in support of the proposed laws at the next session.

The case of a woman, formerly an inmate of the Lincoln State School and Colony for the feeble-minded, was cited as typical by department authorities. Since her release from the institution she has had 18 children, all of whom are said to be mentally incompetent. One of her daughters is married and had 5 children, all mentally incompetent.

It was stated that a city manager bill is being drawn in Chicago, similar to measures defeated at the last session. The Chicago planning commission is said to be taking the lead in this matter. Illinois is one of the few states in the union, according to Dr. A. R. Hatton, president of the commission and head of the political science department of northwestern university, to deny her cities the right to adopt this type of government if they wish.

Remodeling Lincoln Monument, Springfield

Work of remodeling the Lincoln monument in Oak Ridge cemetery, Springfield, is progressing. Dismantling the four monument groups above the high shaft is practically complete. This was necessary to permit workmen to undertake the task of razing the shaft. The statutory represents the four divisions of the army.

An appropriation of \$180,000 was provided by the last general assembly for the remodeling of the monument.
