Field Museum Expedition Making Notable Investigation in Colorado

Permission to excavate a 1,500year old Indian village buried under several huge mounds in southwestern Colorado, and never before touched by the spades of archaeologists, has been granted to an expedition sent out by Field Museum of Natural History, it was announced today by Stephen C. Simms, director of the museum. The United States Department of the Interior, with the sanction of the Smithsonian Institution, has notified Field Museum that it may proceed with the excavation project, Mr. Simms states.

The site to be bared is known as the Lowry Ruin, and is located near Mosa Verde National Park. It is one of the largest sites of its kind in the region, and consists of three great mounds, each about 30 feet high, surrounded by numerous lesser ruins of ceremonial chambers.

### Starts for Location

The Field Museum expedition has departed to begin work at this site. Dr. Paul S. Martin, assistant curator in charge of North American archaeolgog at the museum, is leader of the expedition, which is financed from income derived from a fund established at the museum by Julius Rosenwald and the late Augusta Rosenwald.

It is hoped that when excavations have gotten under way at the mounds there will be revealed quite well preserved remains of the first and second stories of buildings erected by Indians as far back as 1,500 years ago. The people, traces of whose culture are to be sought here, are believed to have been nearly contemporanous with the so-called "cliffdwellers," and to have been the ancestors of the present-day Indian inhabitants of the region.

May Find Beams

It is considered likely that wooden roof beams will be found preserved intact and unrotted, because in the mound they have been sealed safely away from moisture. Evidence of two or three periods of occupancy may be found, according to Dr. Martin. Collections of articles in daily use by these people will be sought, such as pottery, various stone and wooden objects, and turquoise beads. If the expedition obtains the right kind of timber from the buildings it may be possible to compute more closely the approximate date of construction by means of the tree rings.
