Jean Harlow, of Los Angeles, Cal., film actress who was married in Waukegan Sept. 21, 1927, has sued her husband, Charles F. McGrew, 2nd, of Chicago for a divorce on grounds of habitual intoxication.

W. L. Farris, former resident of Half Day and a justice of the peace there until four years ago, was murdered last week in the filling station which he was operating in Lake City, Florida, according to word received by friends.

Steps that will eventually lead to enlargement of Waukegan harbor facilities and development of tonnage in shipping, were outlined at the meeting of the newly formed harbor committee of the Chamber of Commerce, last week.

Joseph Herberger, Sr., 84 years of age, passed away last week at the home of his daughter, Mrs. Emma Kirst, 145 S. Sheridan, Waukegan road. He was a pioneer resident of that city.

A coroner's jury returned a verdict of accidental death by drowning following the inquest into the death of Carl Stahl, Chicago man drowned in Slocum lake.
