Finding Life More Difficult

"Manifestly the male is finding life much more difficult after 40. Infants and young people up to 30 now contribute noticeably less to the total morality and the increase in the percentage of deaths between 30 and 40 has been trivial. In both the 40 and 50 and the 50 to 60 age groups, especially among the males, the increase has been enormous in Chicago and marked down-state.

"The reasons for these changes are not altogether clear. Under modern conditions the struggle for existence among men past 40 has doubtless grown severe and that is an important factor. Men past middle life have not learned to safeguard their own health as well as they insist upon for their wives and children. The baby and the school child are frequently ezamined by physicians and the mothers get the benefit of listening to the advice and of applying the measures prescribed for the youngsters.

"Another factor is the new freedom of women. A greater range of employment in the business world, wider participation in outdoor sports, political enfranchisement and change in mode of dress have resulted not only in pronounced sociological changes in the status of women but have given to them a new outlook on life that is evidently stimulative and beneficial."

## To Change Signal Light System in Libertyville


The Illinois Commerce Commission last week authorized the Chicago, Milwaukee, St. Paul and Pacific railroad to change its crossing light system in Libertyville to more complete equipment.

The order permits the railway to remove its regular wig-wag system at the Milwaukee avenue crossing to flashlight signals with double twoway lamps and rotating stop discs.

These will be automatically controlled by the track circuit upon the approach or departure of a train.


Besides displacing the wig-wag it will relieve a part time flagman of duties.
