LARGE SUM SPENT BY COUNTY SCHOOLS

Superintendent's Report Shows Nearly Half-Million for Buildings

Close to a half million dollars in purchase of grounds, erection of buildings and additions was spent in the school systems through Lake county in the year just closed it is shown in the annual report of T. A. Simpson, county superintendent of schools, which is prepared for the state.

List Expenditures

The Waukegan Township high school spent \$19,921 in improvements under this heading and the elementary school system in Waukegan spent \$40,033. The total for the county was \$385,854.

During the year the high school retired \$41,000 in bonds and \$40,155 in interest while in the elementary system \$31,000 in bonds were paid off and \$27,870 in interest. During the year the high school issued \$389,321 in tax anticipation warrants and the graded schools \$398,503. Tax county totaled \$951,790. A year ago anticipation warrants for the entire the high school drew \$424,267 on warrants of this type and the elementary school \$391,739.

Teachers Get \$1,380,335

Total salaries paid to all teachers of the county ran to \$1,380,335 against \$1,334,689 a year ago. There are 709 teachers in the county instead of 680 as there were a year ago which accounts for the increase. The census, which is inaccurate and seldom up to date, is shown to be 38,331 for all persons under the age of 21 in the county. The Waukegan figures are included in this but are decidedly inaccurate because they remain unchanged year after year as there is no demand to provide them. In spite of this an increase of close to 9,000 is shown for a year as the figures were 29,059 a year ago.

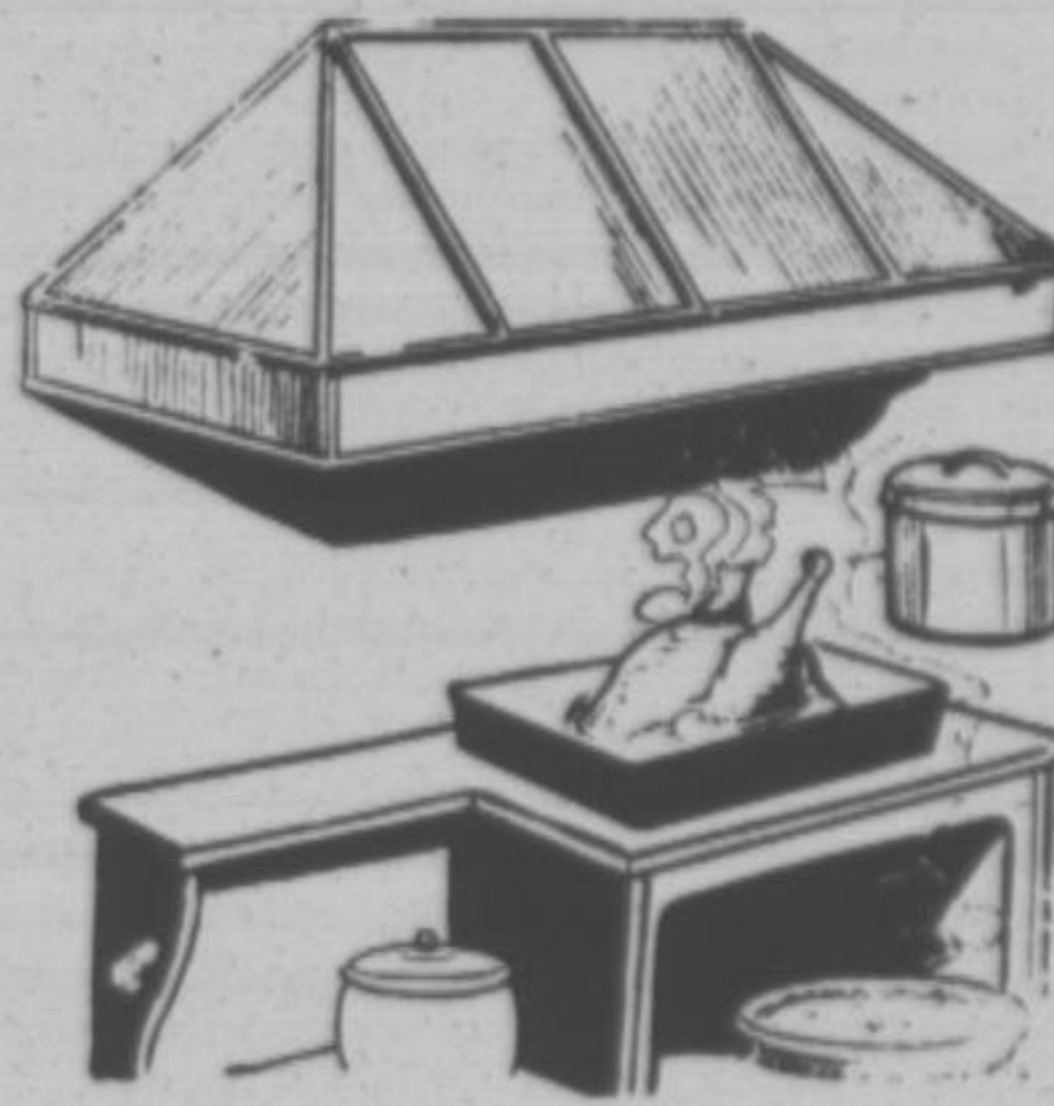
The cash on hand for the entire county as of June 30, 1930 was shown to be \$690,777.

Drives Auto Into One Train and Is Killed When Hit By Another

His closed sedan hurled by a fast southbound Chicago, Milwaukee, St. Paul and Pacific train into the path of a northbound express at the Half Day road crossing north of Deerfield Friday night a man said to be Leonard Grochowski, 50 years old, an interior decorator of Chicago, was instantly killed.

Grochowski was driving his Hudson sedan west on route 22, and Lake Forest police, who investigated, said that he drove directly into the side of the oncoming passenger train and was hurled in front of the engine of the northbound express. The car, a total wreck, was carried some 2,000 feet up the track, before the freight was stopped, and was still caught on the cow catcher.

Traffic over the main line of the railroad was held up for more than an hour as a result of the crash. The ruined sedan finally was removed from the tracks.

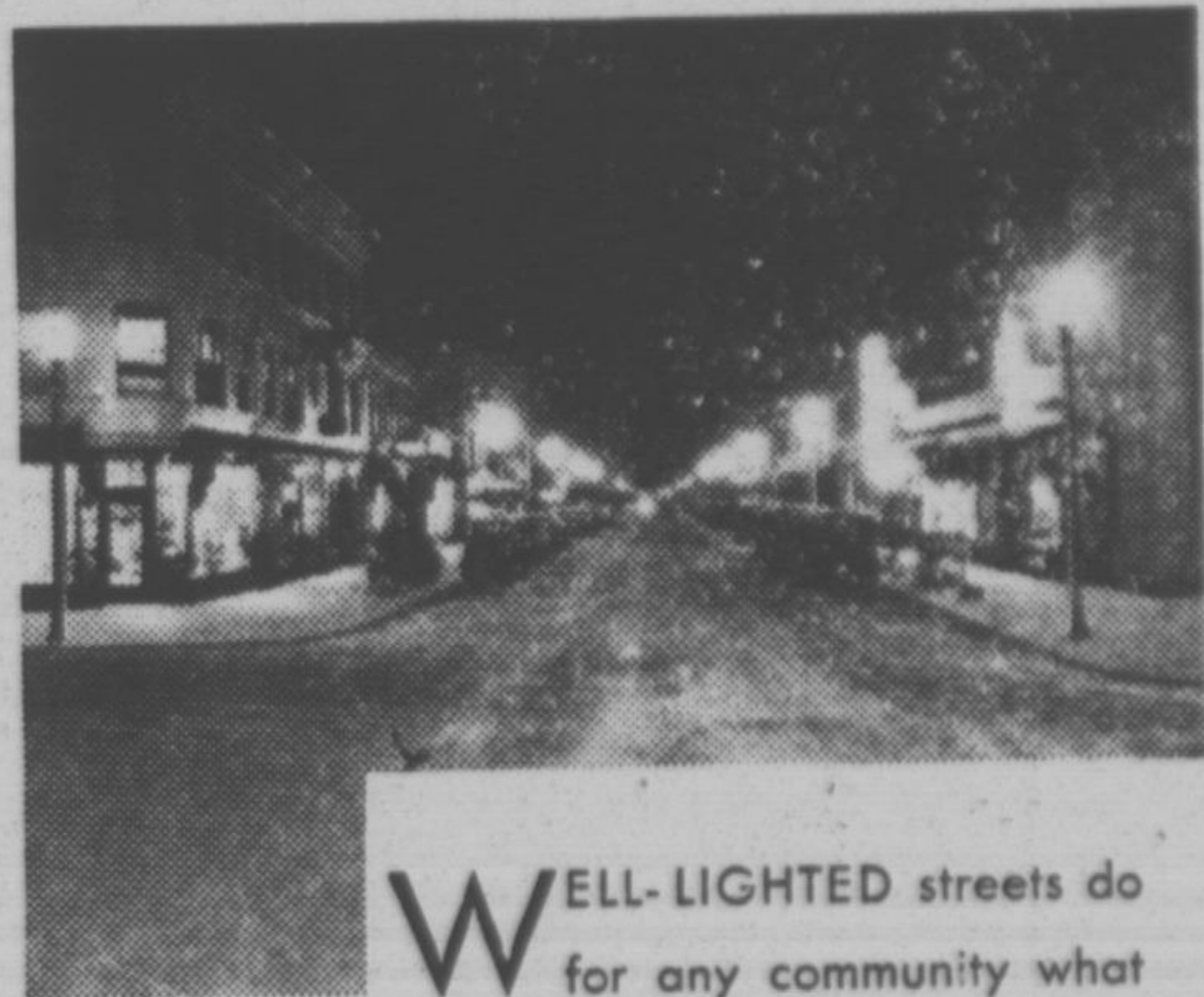
