**Model Country Home
Open For Inspection;
Another Is Under Way**

Something new in model homes is introduced by the Metropolitan District Realty Trust with announcement that one of two country homes just completed at a total cost of approximately \$100,000 in Countryside, two miles west of Mundelein, is now open for public inspection. The home, which has been completely furnished with the co-operation of the Public Service company of Northern, Illinois, may be visited between the hours of 1 and 4 p.m., daily until September 20.

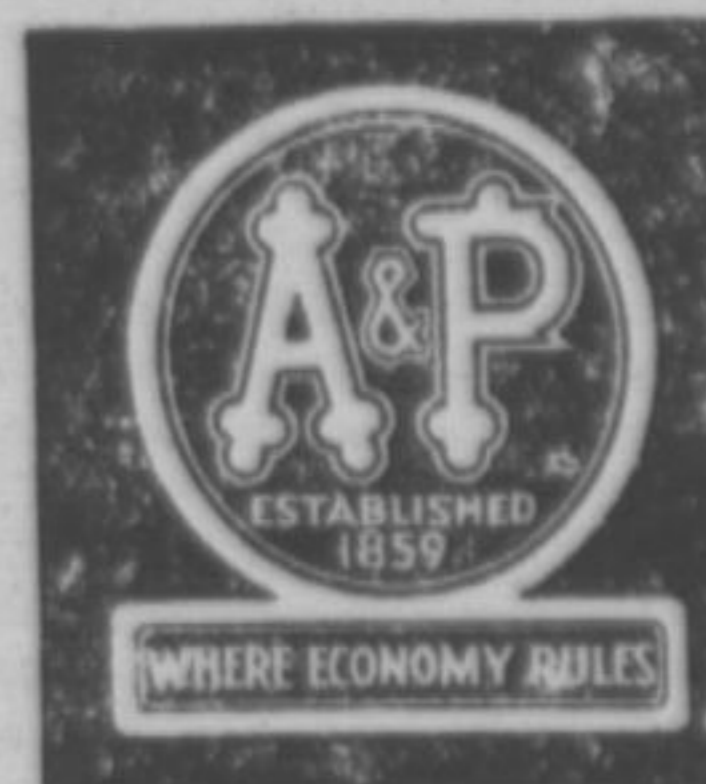
The two homes are the latest addition to the development of this Lake county region as a high-class suburban residential area. Many other fine residences have been erected in Countryside, which has been plotted exclusively for small private estates. Both of the dwellings erected by the Metropolitan District Realty Trust are distinctive for beauty of architecture. One is modeled along the lines of the English country home, while the other is of French Norman design. Each has eight rooms, with a large basement including a playroom with a wood-burning fireplace. Attached to the residences proper are garage and stable, while one structure also includes kennels.

Although located amidst rural surroundings, the homes in Countryside embrace all the modern conveniences and luxuries of the urban residence or apartment. Running water is provided by a private underground system, while gas and electricity are supplied directly by the Public Service company system. Furnace heat, electric refrigeration and all the latest devices adding to the comfort of the home are included in the modern facilities of these country residences.

Occupying plots of approximately two acres each, the homes are situated on private roads winding through the Countryside development. Outdoor recreation facilities abound, both Countryside golf course and playfield being close at hand. Convenient transportation is afforded this new residential area, the North Shore line operating express trains on frequent schedule between the Chicago loop and Mundelein.

Walter Huenemoerder, Libertyville architect, designed the two residences. The general contract was held by the Libertyville Construction company.
