

WORK PROGRESSING ON NEW PARK HERE

Includes 49 Lots on Burton Ave., Between Street and Tracks; Cost, \$200,000

Work of building the new six and a quarter acre park in the Ravinia section of Highland Park, which started last week, is being rushed with the hope that it will be completed and ready for use next spring, Edward M. Laing, superintendent of the East Park district of Highland Park, states.

All paving work and installation of drives and walks will be finished within two weeks, if the E. A. Meyers company, contractors, fulfill their agreement.

Total cost of the improvement, which includes forty-nine lots facing on Burton avenue, north and south of Roger Williams avenue, and immediately adjacent to the Chicago and North Western railroad right-of-way, is estimated at \$200,000.

Designed to serve the rapidly growing southern section of Highland Park, known as Ravinia, the new park will include all modern recreational facilities, for both adults and children, as well as landscaped walks and garden spots. Playground equipment will be installed as soon as the ground work is completed next spring, according to Superintendent Laing.

All but one of the houses located on the new park grounds have been sold or condemned. A spacious one-story building has been moved to the southern extremity of the park on the edge of the future playground. This is being remodelled to serve as a small community and shelter house.

A skating rink will be flooded on the ground immediately north of the shelter house this winter, it was announced. The basement of the structure will be used as a shelter and rest room. Second story of the building will be used in the summer as a recreation and vocational instruction room.

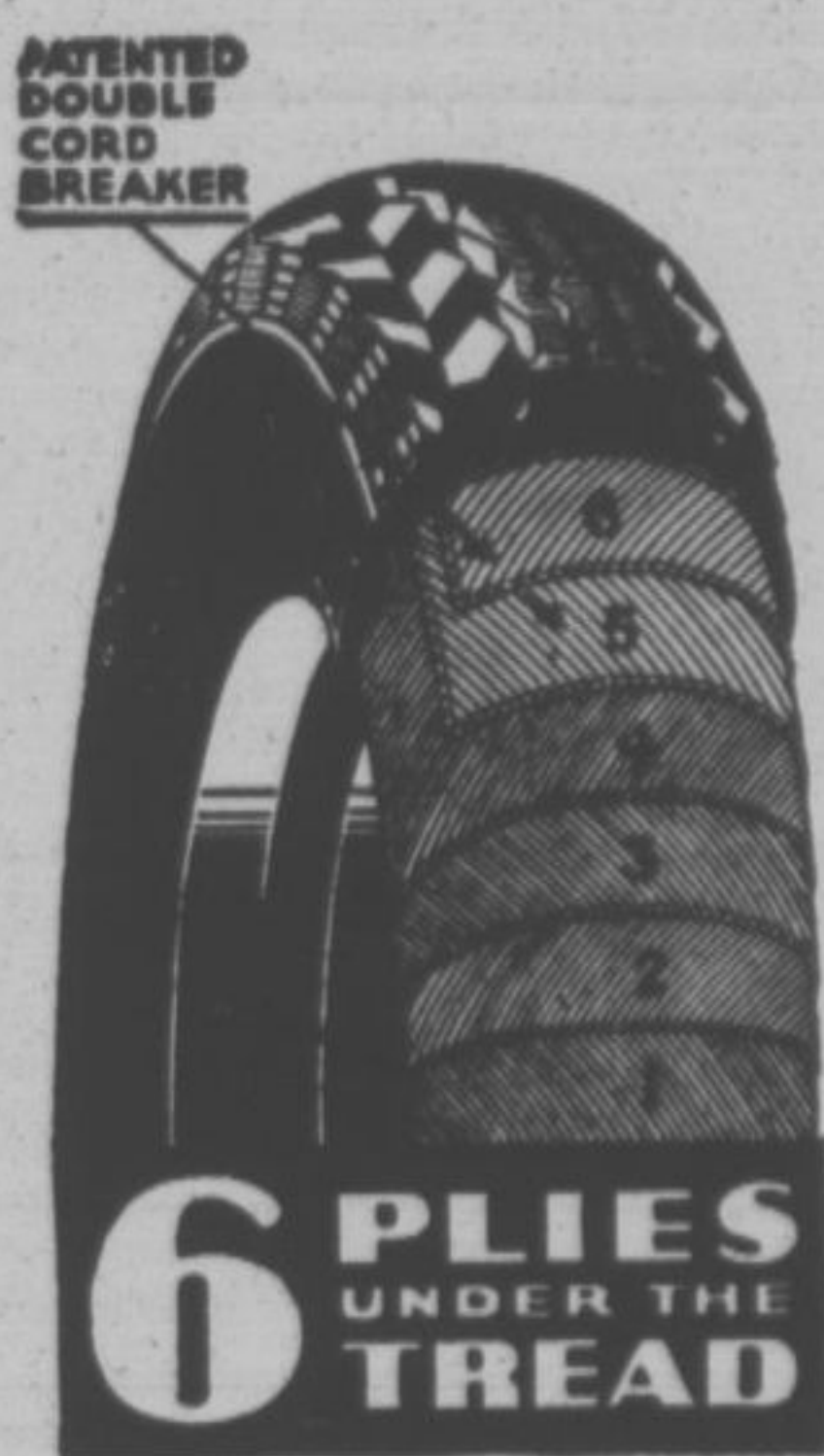
Plans drawn by Superintendent Laing and the engineering firm of Windes & Marsh call for extensive landscaping of the grounds. A park drive back of the North Western station is being constructed, and a two-lane automobile road will be built from the north to the south limits of the grounds, south of Roger Williams avenue.

Addition to this area will bring the total acreage controlled by the Highland Park East Park district up to 275 acres, exclusive of the Sunset Valley golf course.
