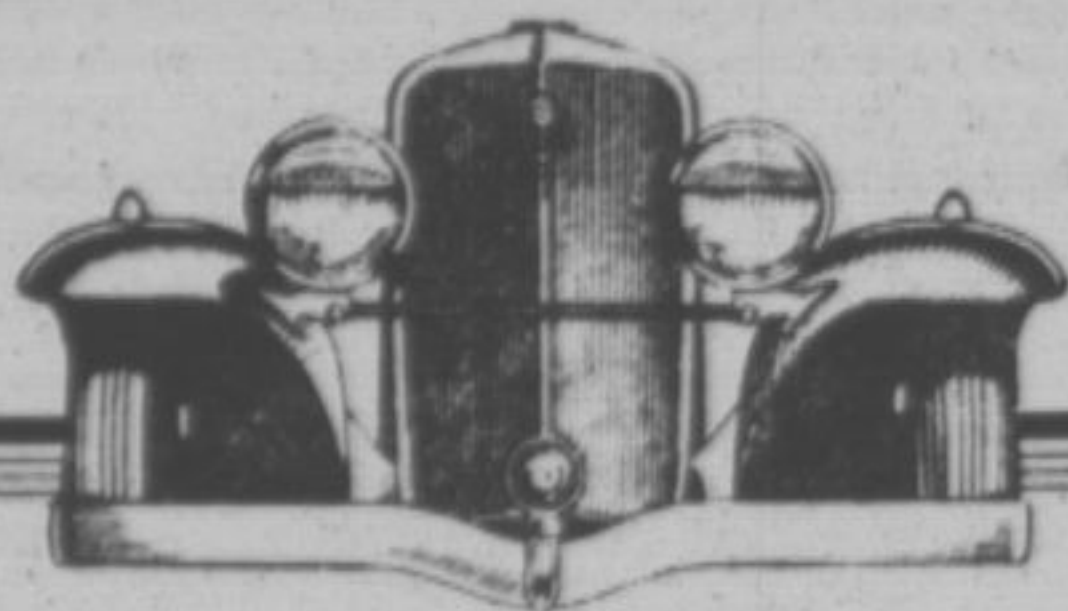

Words Often Misused

Do not say, "I shall go in spite of the weather." Say, "despite the weather."

Do not say, "Neither John nor Frank were there." Say, "was there," as in this case "neither" is singular. "Neither the boys nor the girls were there" is correct.

Do not say, "I feel kind of dubious about the outcome." Say, "I feel somewhat dubious."

Do not say, "I took the paper off of the table." Omit "of."

Do not say, "I am taller than him." Say, "taller than he 'is tall.'"

Do not say, "He plays pretty good." Say, "He plays fairly well."

Words Often Mispronounced

Predicament. Pronounce first syllable pre, not per.

Evasive. Pronounce last syllable siv, not ziv.

Chateau. Pronounce sha-to, a as in "father," o as in "no," accent last syllable.

Ask Pronounce the a as in "path," not as in "at."

Oath. Pronounce the th as in "thin," not as in "at."

Satirical; first a unstressed, both i's as in "it," accent after the r.

Words Often Misspelled

Alien; not alein. Shaping; no e after the p. Alege; not alledge. Carat (a jeweler's weight); carrot (a vegetable.) Solely; note the lel. Equalize; ize, not ise.

Synonyms

Build, erect, construct, frame, found, raise.

Flock, drove, herd, pack, covey, swarm.

Fluctuate, vibrate, oscillate, undulate, vacillate, waver.

Desperate, despairing, hopeless, despondent, disconsolate, forlorn.

Bulk, size, volume, mass.

Limp, flacid, flexible, flabby, flimsy, limber.
