

Prisoner Escapes at Ft. Sheridan Monday

Fort Sheridan authorities reported the escape of a federal prisoner Monday night when Theodore Robinson affected an escape. According to the officer of the day, who supplied north shore police with a description of the man, he is said to be 26 years old. His former home is listed as 1545 Paris street, Gary, Ind.

The mob which lynched two prisoners in the Marion, Ind., jail recently, was incited to a violence by a few hot headed leaders. If they had been arrested for such incitation the American Civil Liberties Union presumably would have defended them on the theory that the advocacy of violence against the government comes within the federal Constitution's protection of free speech.

der of the receipts came from non-residents.

The same arrangement for parking cars was provided at Central park as last year—no charge to holders of identification cards, and non-residents paid a total of \$739.55 for parking 1,930 cars, at 25 cents on week days and 50 cents on Sundays and holidays. The tickets sold show that 3,565 non-residents thus enjoyed beach privileges during the season. To residents of the district 1,814 identification cards were distributed.

Receipts and Disbursements

Receipts at the beaches for June, July, August and September, according to the report, totaled \$3,462.70, distributed as follows: Parking, \$739.55; rentals, \$77.85; lockers, \$1,230.35; \$602.50; concessions, \$812.45. Disbursements totaled \$3,434.32, leaving a balance of \$28.38. The expenses

included labor, supplies and miscellaneous disbursements.

Playground Report

The summary of playground activities, according to the report, shows that attendance at the several parks was: Sunset park, 11,680; Ravinia, 4,743; Port Clinton, 1,199; Lincoln, 144; total, 17,766. The registration at each was: Sunset, 465; Ravinia, 727; Port Clinton, 75; Lincoln, 49; total, 861. The percentage of attendance per registration was: Sunset, 55; Ravinia, 38; Port Clinton, 35; Lincoln playground was not attended by a sufficient number to warrant its operation, the report continues. While the percentage at Port Clinton playground does not represent the situation, inasmuch as this was the first season of its operation, the last half of the season the percentage was 45.

The cost of providing instructors for the playgrounds per attendance based on the amount appropriated was 8.4 cents for each child registered, and for each child registered for the season it was \$1.74, the report says.

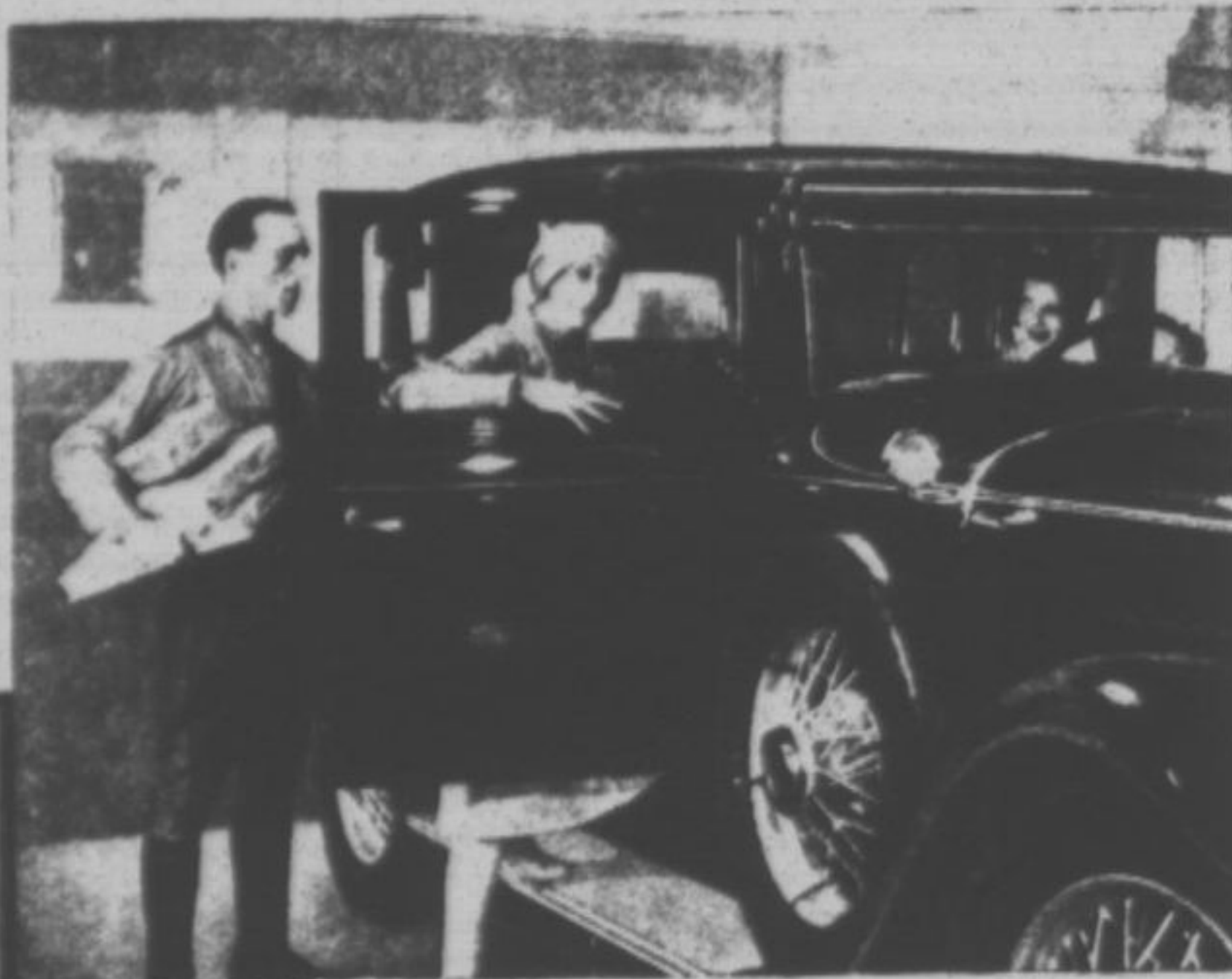

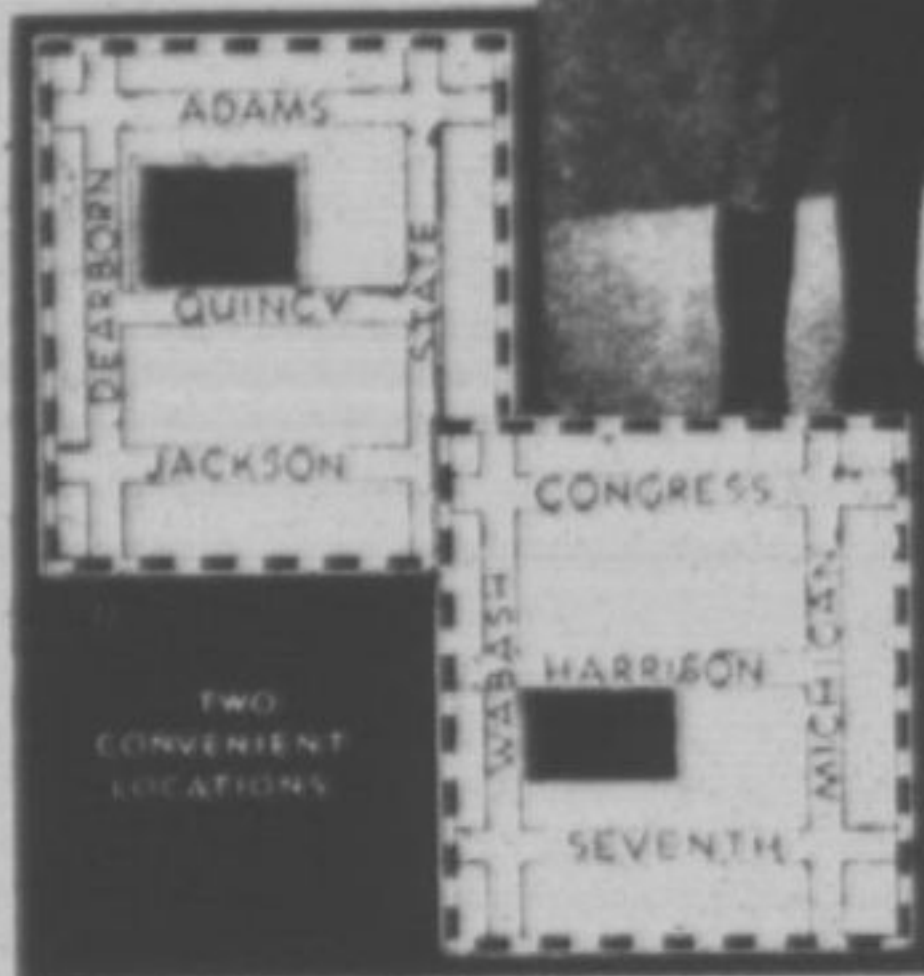
