BRIEF NEWS ITEMS FROM LAKE COUNTY

Happenings About This Part of the North Shore; County Seat Doings

Bandits last week held up a Waukegan street car and relieved the motorman of his night's receipts totalling \$17. The robbery occurred at the end of the North avenue car line, near the intersection of Greenwood avenue.

A concerted bombardment of everything with wings September 24 in the lake regions of the county where more than 3,000 hunters banged away at the first flight of ducks as the inaugural of the 1930 hunting season.

Eight men were badly injured in a free-for-all fight that followed an attempt of four men to crash a party being held at the Rundgren cottage at Ingleside last week.

Fifteen duck hunters were arrested by the game warden near Grass lake on the morning of September 24, for firing their guns before the official hunting season in Illinois started at sunrise.

S. S. Shapiro, the Milwaukee tailor who is out on \$5,000 bond in connection with the death of Mrs. Louise Spiegel of 114 South Elmwood avenue, Waukegan, and her child who was born after an automobile accident, is being sued for \$10,000 for the death of the woman.

Accompanied by his wife, Jasper DePew, WCB radio announcer, and Carl L. Huth, his private secretary, Wilbur Glenn Voliva, general overseer of Zion, left last week for Vancouver, Canada, on the first lap of a world tour. The party will return to Zion in 10 months, Voliva said.

County Judge P. L. Persons last week sustained Fox lake objectors to a \$25,000 paving project for Lake avenue when he held that the assessment roll was illegal on the grounds that it had not been prepared by the man commissioned to complete the task.

Proposal to Make North Chicago Separate Town

The proposal to convert North Chicago into a separate township is meeting with approval throughout that city and it is expected that direct action will soon result.

The plan to create a separate township was advocated primarily so that the school children in North Chicago would be able to receive their schooling there without having to pay for transportation and daily meals. If a high school is constructed the children will be able to go home during the noon hour and walk to and from school at night.

These two factors are the main expense to the students going to school, and it would be a real problem to remedy the situation.

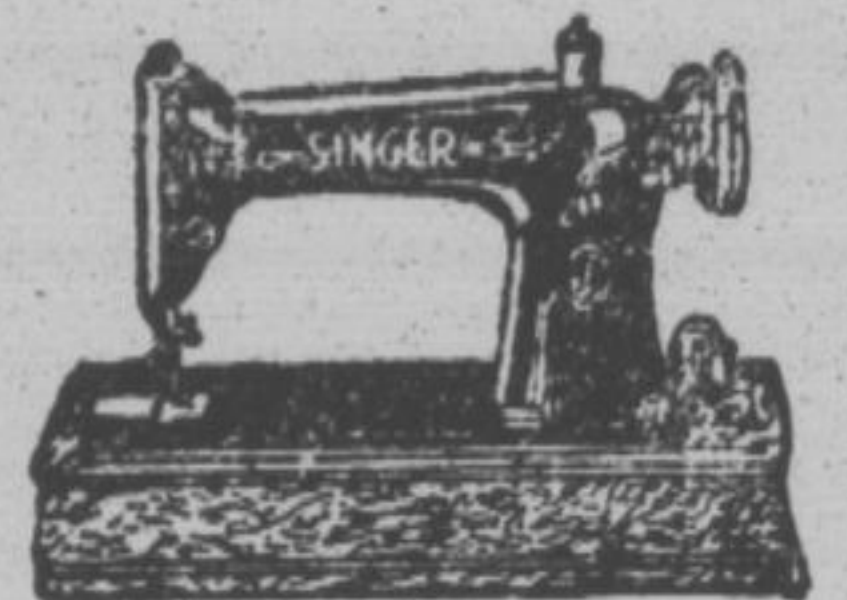
