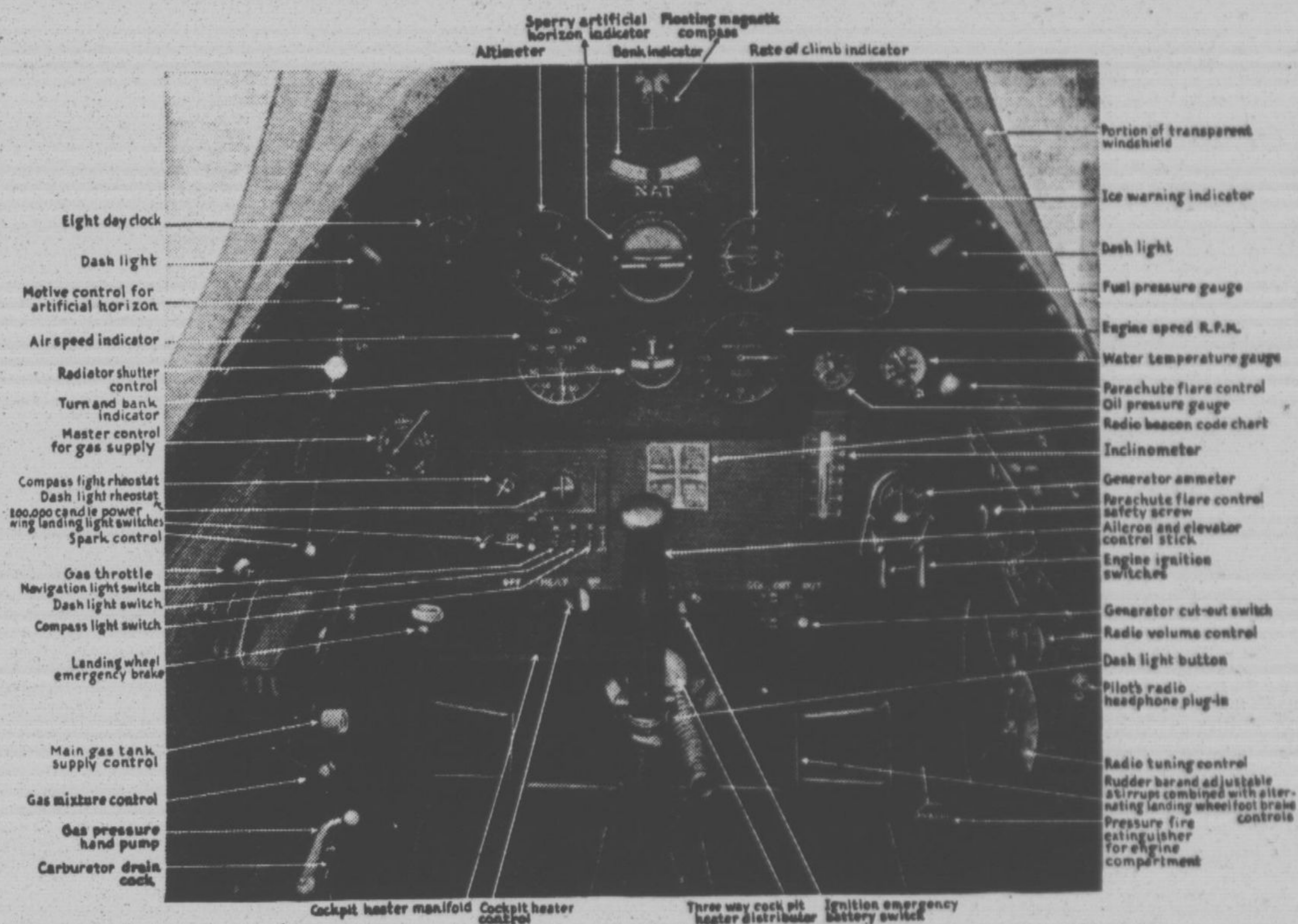


Cockpit and Instrument Board of Mail and Express Plane
