

the majority of workers in the building industry must be employed.

Only a small percentage of these workmen are employed today. If the general public, the business men, bankers, mortgage companies, etc., really want a return of good times, any building operations contemplated should be started now.

Wages of Mechanics

A great deal has been said about wages of building mechanics. The public does not know that the yearly average wage of a skilled building mechanic, even in good times, is less than \$2150.

Loss of time for various reasons beyond the control of the mechanic, such as unfavorable weather conditions, changing from one job to another, etc., constitutes quite a financial loss to the mechanic during the course of a year's time; this, in addition to the fact that he must serve an apprenticeship of four years, pass a rigid examination and have quite an investment in tools, makes it necessary that his rate per hour be such as to bring his yearly salary up to a point that will assure comfort for his dependents, encourage him to be a desirable citizen, and lend his support to the upbuilding of the community in which he lives.

Members of contractors' associations negotiate and establish wage agreements because it is very necessary for the reason that it would be impossible for a contractor to figure on a job and submit an intelligent estimate to his client if wages were subject to frequent fluctuations.

Basis of Computing Wages

On a basis of wage stability, both the owner and contractor can compute cost definitely. Were this not so, the wages of the craft would be governed by the highest bidder for his services, and in times of depression would be reduced to slavery.

Real ustate values would correspond with wage fluctuations and appraisals could not be correctly made. The value of securities would likewise be affected, and the arrangement of loans greatly handicapped.

Building Logic

In this connection, it might be well to dwell briefly upon a few items of building logic. Nothwithstanding that much has been written on the subject of building, the very fact that any building venture, be it a modest home or towering sky-scraper, represents an investment, often-time the savings of a long and hard struggle, too much sound building logic will never be chronicled, and it behooves the prospective builder to seek all possible information that originates from reliable sources.

In selecting a site for the building, consideration must be given to the purpose that the structure is to serve, viz: industrial, mercantile, home for industrial workers, high class residential, etc. Zoning ordinances should be studied, so that the type of structure will comply therewith. Advancing ground values makes it advisable that a survey of the property be made and boundaries established.


