

**Hendee and Bullock
Elected Heads of Two
State Organizations**

County Clerk Lew A. Hendee last week was elected president of the Supervisors, County Commissioners, County and Probate Clerks, County Auditors and Treasurers of Illinois in the annual convention at Springfield.

At the same time Probate Clerk John R. Bullock was elected president of the probate clerk's division.

The honor came to Hendee after he had served as secretary of the organization of county officials of the state for 17 years. During the past year, however, he was in the office of vice president.

The convention closed Oct. 1 in Springfield after a three day session

in which problems of officials were discussed.

The next convention city is uncertain as the matter was sent back to the executive committee with instructions to settle on the date and the place of the 1931 meeting.

Thomas Ryan, 45, former Waukegan man and well known in that city, suffered the loss of his left foot last week when he was struck and run over by an interurban train in Racine, Wis.
