SEEK ORGANIZATION AS SEPARATE TOWNS

North Chicago and Winthrop Harbor May Petition County Board

Two more districts in the county are considering asking the county board of supervisors to set up towns for them, and if North Chicago carries out its intentions, the board will have a busy December session setting up new commonwealths.

Tentative plans in old Benton Township, known as the Town of Benton in its political make-up, indicate that before the shouting and fighting dies there will be three towns, Zion, Winthrop Harbor and Beach.

Names Chosen

Residents in the Beach and Winthrop Harbor section and Independents in Zion are fighting the Voliva plans for the completion of his town contiguous with the city limits of Zion but if this fight fails the residents in the south end of what would be the new Town of Benton would petition or organize as the Town of Beach and those in the north end would ask to be allowed to establish the Town of Winthrop Harbor.

The unfortunate thing, Voliva antagonists point out, the new Town of Zion absolutely splits the new Town of Benton leaving one-half of the property hanging on the south limits of Zion and the other half on the north.

Divided by Zion

Without any land or water connecting link it would be next to impossible to maintain such a town government, these objectors point out, and the only solution would be two towns instead of one.

The city of North Chicago, that lacks representation on the county board because half of the city is in Shields and half in Waukegan, is planning to ask for the creation of the Town of North Chicago in December and if all of these developments come by December the county will establish more townships in a year than were made in the last quarter of a century.
