NIGHT POLICEMAN FIRES AT BANDITS

Joseph Brazo, 25, who was instantly killed. Yenato Santos and Jack Smith Brazo's companions, fled during the gunfire, but were picked up by cruising policemen.

Friday morning's shooting aroused residents in the neighborhood of the cafe, 5 S. St. Johns avenue. Loesch was making his rounds at 2:45 o'clock and had just turned a corner when he came upon the two men who had drilled a hole through the door.

Fires at Pair

For a moment, the patrolman's surprise was as great as that of the two burglars. For a fraction of a second Loesch halted and then reached for his gun, calling to the two men to put their hands up. They dropped the tools (including a sledge hammer) which they had been using in the attempt to jimmy the door, and ran.

Loesch followed them a few steps, and then fired twice at the retreating forms, 50 feet away.

Gets Description

Loesch accurately described both men. One, the man who he wounded, was six feet tall, he said, and wore dark clothing. The other, five feet six inches tall, wore a light topcoat. They were about 25 years old, Loesch said.

Police Chief Edward Moroney declared that the search for the two bandits would be continued until they were caught. Aid of other north shore police and Chicago detectives has been enlisted.

a chance to renew its ravages. Fungi are really of vegetable origin, unable to manufacture their own food, because of the lack of chlorophyll or green coloring matter, hence are dependent on their host for nourishment, destroying the plant tissues as they grow. The standard remedy against these various diseases is bordeaux mixture, used in various strengths according to time of application and existing conditions. The surface of the leaf and twigs are covered with a protecting film of fungicide during the season when the particular disease is prevalent, so that when the spores (or seeds of the disease) lodge on the tree or plant, they are killed before they can take root.

Success in all spraying operations depends entirely on thorough and timely applications with the proper materials, therefore it is imperative that the persons to whom you entrust your spraying are conscientious and thorough operators, equipped with powerful sprayers capable of covering every leaf and twig no matter how large the trees.

NOTICE is hereby given to all persons interested that the City Council of the City of Highland Park, having ordered a local improvement consisting of the acquiring of a right-of-way and widening an existing right-of-way for a public street and sidewalk from the south city limits of the City of Highland Park at a point in the southerly boundary line of Lot 2 in the subdivision of the West 22½ acres of the South 30 acres of the East One-Half of the Southwest Quarter of Section 35, Township 43 North, Range 12, East of the Third Principal Meridian, and extending to the Northwesterly City Limits of Highland Park, being the Center Line of Buena Road, at a point on said Buena Road East of and Adjacent to the right-of-way of the Public Service Company of Northern Illinois, also known as the Skokie Valley Route of the Chicago, North Shore & Milwaukee Railroad, the ordinance for the same being on file in the office of the City Clerk of said City and the said City having applied to the County Court of Lake County, State of Illinois, for an assessment of the cost of said improvement, according to the benefits and an assessment therefore having been made and returned to said Court (Docket No. 344), the final hearing thereon will be held on the 10th day of November, 1930, at 9:00 o'clock A.M., or as soon thereafter as the business of the court will permit.

Said ordinance provides that the aggregate amount of said assessment shall be divided into twenty (20) installments bearing interest at the rate of Six (6) per cent per annum as by statute in such case made and provided.

All persons desiring may file objections in said court before said day and may appear at the hearing and make their defense.
