**Meeting Here Nov. 7 to
Discuss Rates for Gas**

Officials of cities and villages served by the North Shore Gas company will meet on Nov. 7, probably at Highland Park to decide what action they will take in the matter of a cut in rates of the North Shore Gas company, says the Waukegan Times. Plans for the conference were tentatively worked out by Mayor L. J. Yager of Waukegan in meetings with Commissioner Lyle Gourley of Highland Park and Mayor Nelson Gonyo of Winthrop Harbor, it is stated. The report continues:

"The officials will consider plans for bringing the matter before the Illinois Commerce commission. This action follows the refusal on the part of the company to voluntarily lower the rates for its service.

"Ten cities and villages have joined with Waukegan in the fight for lower rates. They are North Chicago, Lake Bluff, Lake Forest, Highwood, Highland Park, Glencoe, Kenilworth, Winnetka, Zion and Libertyville is the only other community being served by the company but which has not passed on the matter.

**Christmas Packages
for Foreign Lands:
When to Mail Them**

In order that patrons may be fully advised concerning the dates on which articles should be mailed to assure delivery in the country of destination on or before Christmas day, there is furnished herewith a list showing approximately the latest dates articles should be posted for each country concerned.

Due to the customs formalities which must, in most cases, be complied with in connection with parcel post packages, it is difficult to state definitely the exact time to assure delivery to addressee and such articles should be mailed in advance of the date given whenever possible so as to connect with earlier steamers and avoid delay due to congestion in foreign post offices:
