

### Legislative Work of Legion Outlined in Resolutions Adopted

Boston, Mass. — Delegates to the recent national convention of the American Legion here approved a report of the committee on national legislation which included several resolutions on legislative matters. The resolutions approved by the committee and the convention embodied the following requests and proposals:

Creation of a separate committee in the Senate to consider veterans' affairs.

Extension of the time for filing applications under the Tyson-Fitzgerald Act.

Adequate and full compensation for the armed forces of the United States.

A resolution requesting that women who served as veterans be included in the census.

Removal of the time limit for World war citations.

Preservation and publication of military and naval records.

Endorsement of H. R. 13224 to give all retired officers their highest war rank.

A resolution to make public lands in Alaska available to ex-service men.

Tax exemption for cigarettes given to hospital patients.

A resolution to allow World war veterans attending the National Convention of the American Legion the same privileges secured Spanish war veterans.

A resolution appreciating the work of the Legislative committee.

Establishment of more employment offices under the Labor Bureau.

A resolution requesting access to files in the Veterans' Bureau in case of insurance suits.

Payment of adjusted compensation in full to dependents of deceased veterans who died prior to the passage of the Act.

Payment in full of adjusted compensation certificates to permanently totally disabled men.

A resolution to give veterans in civil service in all departments credit for war service.

Another resolution dealing with the rate of interest charged on Adjusted Service certificate loans was referred to the legislative committee by the unanimous consent of the convention. The committee adopted the following resolution which was approved by the convention: "Whereas, the rate of interest on loans on Adjusted Service certificates amounts to

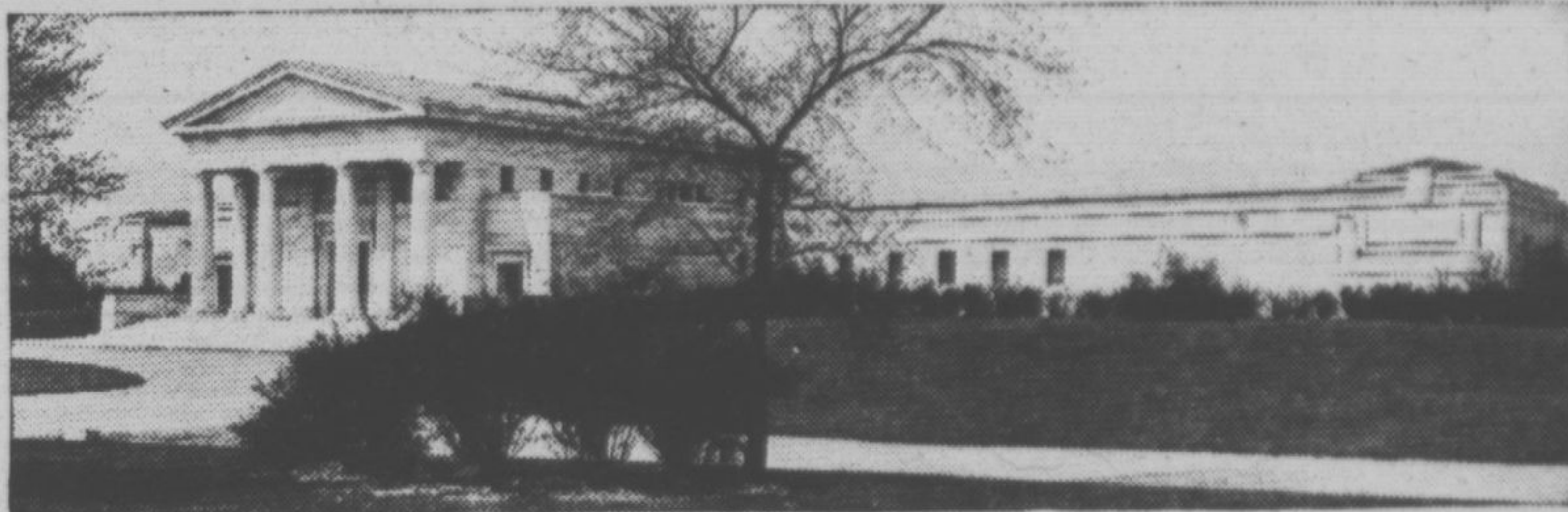
6 per cent per annum and does over the life of the certificate consume to a large extent the face value of the certificate; and whereas, such loans are annually relieving much distress; therefore be it resolved that the rate of interest on Adjusted Service certificate loans to be 4 per cent and not compounded."
