

SCORES PRIMARY LAW IN ADDRESS

Judge Shurtleff Before Waukegan Kiwanians Points Out Its Defects

In a scathing denunciation of the direct primary law Judge Edward Shurtleff last week told a group of Kiwanians in Waukegan that such a system can never be operated successfully. He advocated the convention system of choosing candidates for various public offices. In addition he told of the work done by the judicial commission and their report made the governor of the state Judge Shurtleff is a member of the commission, says the Waukegan Times.

The jurist's ire was around against the primary system largely because at the present time, in his opinion, any man can claim that he is a Democrat, Republican or member of any party and run for public office. Each candidate, under the present system, said the speaker, makes his own platform with little or no control from the party.

Under the convention system, Judge Shurtleff asserted, all this would be changed. Political leaders of various districts would gather and map out a party platform. They would then pick the men, who best represented that party and put them up as candidates.

Takes Up Criminal Code

Commenting on the proposed revision of the Illinois criminal code, the jurist stated that under the arrange-

ments made crime would be classified into five distinct groups, each group having a series of subdivisions. Under the first class would come murderers, bandits and various other vicious criminals. He contended that this would be a simplification of the statutes. All criminals would be under the direction of the superintendent of public welfare. The penalty for a conviction on first division crimes would be life. Pardon would be subject to the approval of the superintendent of public welfare.

Judge Shurtleff declared that he intends to offer an amendment to the first classification of crimes that would make it criminal for any person holding public office, except the governor, to aid in the supervision of testimony or urge probation of criminals. He also would make it a first class crime for the attorney general or state's attorneys to fail to prosecute in criminal cases.

Millions and millions of baby fish have been used in restocking the lakes of Lake county this year, according to Henry Kern, deputy fish and game warden. Twice this year this work has been done. The third efforts along this line were started last week with State Representatives Lee McDonough of Waukegan and Richard Lyons of Mundelein taking an active part in the work.

Wall-eyed pike have been placed in every lake in the county, as have blue gills, sun fish and crappies. Brook trout have been placed in some of the lakes as an experiment.

To Interest Children in Conservation Plan

In that the forests and timber supplies of the future will depend upon the attitude of the coming generation, Lewis B. Springer, chief forester in the state department of conservation, plans to interest school children, by scouts and other people in the importance of preserving and replenishing the state's resources in the form of growing timber. Instructive literature, relative to the forest trees of Illinois, and their preservation, soon will be available to leaders in educational movements that will cooperate.

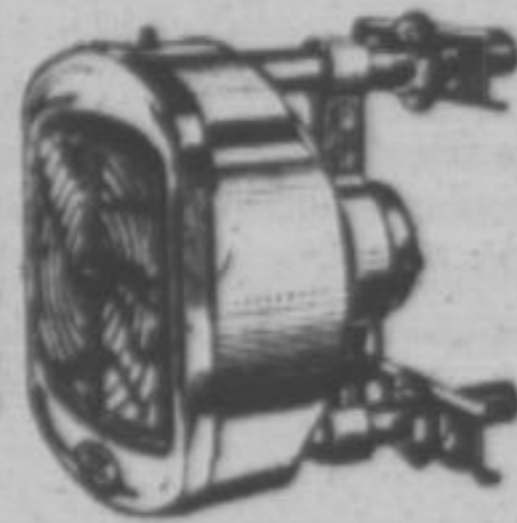
