

Governor Says Illinois Leads in Road Building

Governor Louis L. Emmerson, in an address before more than 100 highway engineers, representing many foreign countries, on an inspection tour of the Illinois road system, asserted that within a period of the years, Illinois has changed from one of the muddiest states in the Union to the leader of the nation in good roads construction. He added that "nearly 4,000 miles of main arteries remain to be paved within the next

few years, and a great network of secondary roads must be surfaced before we have a system that is anywhere near complete." He pointed out that, for the completion of the task outlined—connecting every Illinois community with an improved highway—the required finances are in sight, due to the enactment of gasoline tax legislation.
