

New Method Which May Prove of Value

Spring thaws will test the "world's first metal base highway."

If it withstands "soft" weather

The highway is a 150-foot section instead of concrete.

Springfield-but based on iron plates It was opened to traffic in October and will undergo service tests until after the spring thaws to determine

its durability. Outwardly, the experimental section looks the same as the rest of the brick pavement, but it is claimed to have greater flexibility to withstand shocks of heavy traffic and stresses of heat and cold.

Base of Sheet Iron

The base was made of large sections of sheet iron, two-thirds being corrugated and the remainder flat plates. They were laid directly on the subgrade soil. Over them was spread a cushion of sand and tar before the bricks were set.


Its builders expect the new type of construction to save time and money because the concrete base is eliminated, doing away with the necessity of excavating and of waiting for a cement layer to set.

If spring thaws are weathered by the section, they believe "portable" roads may be manufactured, with the iron base, cushion and bricklaying done in plants and merely assembled on the site of construction.

The experiment is a cooperative venture between the Illinois state highway department, Sangamon county highway superintendent and board of supervisors, and manufacturers of the materials used.

#### Illinois Ranks Second in Number of Marriages

Illinois ranked second in the nation in the number of marriages last year, 81,092, and also in the number of divorces, 15,760, according to a statistical report issued by the United States department of commerce. New York led in the number of marriages and Texas in the number of divorces. Nevada ranked highest in ratio of marriages to population, 63.7 to every 1,000 residents, and divorces, 28 per 1,000 of population. The high marriage ratio was attributed by the government to an adjoining state, California, having adopted strict marriage laws.
