WARNS HUNTERS OF RABBIT FEVER

University Expert Points Out Danger of Tuleraemia to Humans

Beginning November 10, the sportsman of Lake county have four additional varieties of game to fill their bags. They are rabbits, quail, prairie chickens and pheasants until Nov. 15.

Rabbit hunters are warned by Dr. Lloyd Arnold, University of Illinois college of medicine, against shooting the bunnies that sit and wait for them.

Beware of "Easy Ones"

The rabbit that is easy to get, the doctor said, is sick and probably infected with the treacherous tuleraemia, or "rabbit fever." Tuleraemia will be more prevalent this year than last, Dr. Arnold predicts.

"One way to prevent tuleraemia," he said, "is to avoid contact with infected carcasses, infected wood ticks and the contaminated horse-fly."

"The rabbit is the natural host of the bacterium causing tuleraemia. The disease is transmitted from rabbit to rabbit by ticks and lice. This

bacterium can be passed from one generation of ticks to another through the eggs.

"These infected ticks can cause the disease when they bite man. The horse-fly can also transmit the disease. The common means of infection in man is to dress or handle the rabbit infected with the disease."

Warning Issued

"It is not necessary to have a scratch or an abrasion of the skin to acquire the disease," Dr. Arnold pointed out. "One can get the disease by touching a diseased rabbit. The old theory that a person could become afflicted only by the transmission of tuleraemia through an open wound is fallacious."

The university doctor also warned against the picking up of dead rabbits for their pelts.

"This is an easy way to acquire the disease," he added, "which means an illness that is likely to linger a year, and all for making a sum of less than a dollar."

Last year there were 29 cases of "rabbit fever" reported in Illinois, an increase of six over the preceding year.
