Three more residents of Lake county have been awarded patents on inventions, according to word from the United States patent office of Washington.

The three and the nature of the inventions are: Frederick A. Preston, Lake Forest, rail anchor; W. J. Taylor, Winthrop Harbor, conveyor system, and Edward M. Laing, Highland Park, golf ball washer.

J. T. Cowley of Syracuse, N. Y., was associated with W. J. Taylor in the invention of the conveyor system the records show.

In all of the cases the inventors had waited for more than four years to obtain their patents.

### Ohio State to Play Illinois at Urbana in Final Game Nov. 22

A thrilling and exciting struggle is expected when Ohio State and Illinois close the football season in the Illinois stadium Saturday, Nov. 22.

That football lovers are realizing this is indicated by a steady increase in the demand for accommodations. The crowd will not come near to taxing the stadium capacity but it will be swelled at the last minute by many fans. C. E. Bowen, ticket manager, announces that seats in the main stands between the goal lines will be available for all-comers.

Ohio State is now regarded as one of the strong teams in the conference by reason of a victory over Notre Dame by a larger score than was made against the sailors by Notre Dame. Before then Ohio tied Wisconsin, one of the strongest Big Ten teams.

That Illinois will close the season with a victory is the hope of the Illini supporters. Bob Zuppke will muster every resource and inspired by the ancient rivalry with the Buckeyes, it is predicted Illinois will play the best game of the campaign.

Illinois has had the fortune or misfortune to play four of the strongest teams in the country just when its football material was not as good as usual. These teams, Northwestern, Michigan, Purdue and Army, were tough opposition for a young eleven. Ohio State is good but not in the hope that Illines' lane will turn.

This will be the last appearance in Illinois suits of several Illini, notably Stan Bodman and Ott Hills, tackle, John Ovelman and Bob Conover, guards, Tiny Huddleston, center and Olaf Robinson and Chuck Hall, backs. These seniors especially hope that Illinis' lane will turn a blaze of glory.

### Evanston May Soon Have Police Radio Service

That Evanston police would be united with the Chicago department through the medium of radio within the next two weeks seemed assured last week, when Chief of Police William O. Freeman, of Evanston, was notified that the city council last night appropriated \$275 which is to be used at once to equip two Evanston police squad cars with short wave broadcast receivers as an aid in their campaign against criminals.

A few hours previous to the passage of the appropriation a group of those identified with the Chicago police radio system visited Evanston and staged a demonstration of various types of sets now in use for keeping squads in the field informed with last minute news in the crime situation.
