### Two Die of Injuries in H. P. Hospital; Auto Accidents Are Cause

Edward Gitelson of 6757 Sheridan road, Chicago, and Gordon Christensen, of Prairie View, died Thursday night of last week in the Highland Park hospital following serious injuries received in two automobile accidents early this week.

Gitelson suffered a fractured skull in a crash late Wednesday night of last week when the automobile in which he was riding with six members of a theatrical troupe returning from Waukegan, collided with a truck during a heavy fog on Waukegan road, just across the Cook county line.

#### Five Others Hurt

He was rushed to the Highland Park hospital, along with other members of the party, who were only slightly injured. They are: Mrs. Vida Viera, 28, of 4541 Sheridan road, a dancer; Angello Gigianti, 32, of 917 Blue Island avenue, an actor; Abraham Williams 32, of 3537 S. Michigan avenue also an actor; Tony Camarata, 25, of 3130 West Fifty-fourth place, driver of the car, and his father, Charles.

Gitelson was a theatrical booking agent. The party with which he was riding was returning from an Armistic day entertainment they had given for the American Legion in Waukegan.

#### Pinned Under Car

Gordon Christensen, 18, of Prairie View, was found underneath the wreckage of his automobile in Highland Park Wednesday night. He was badly bruised, but was not thought to be in a serious condition. He was operated upon Thursday afternoon for serious internal injuries and died that night.
