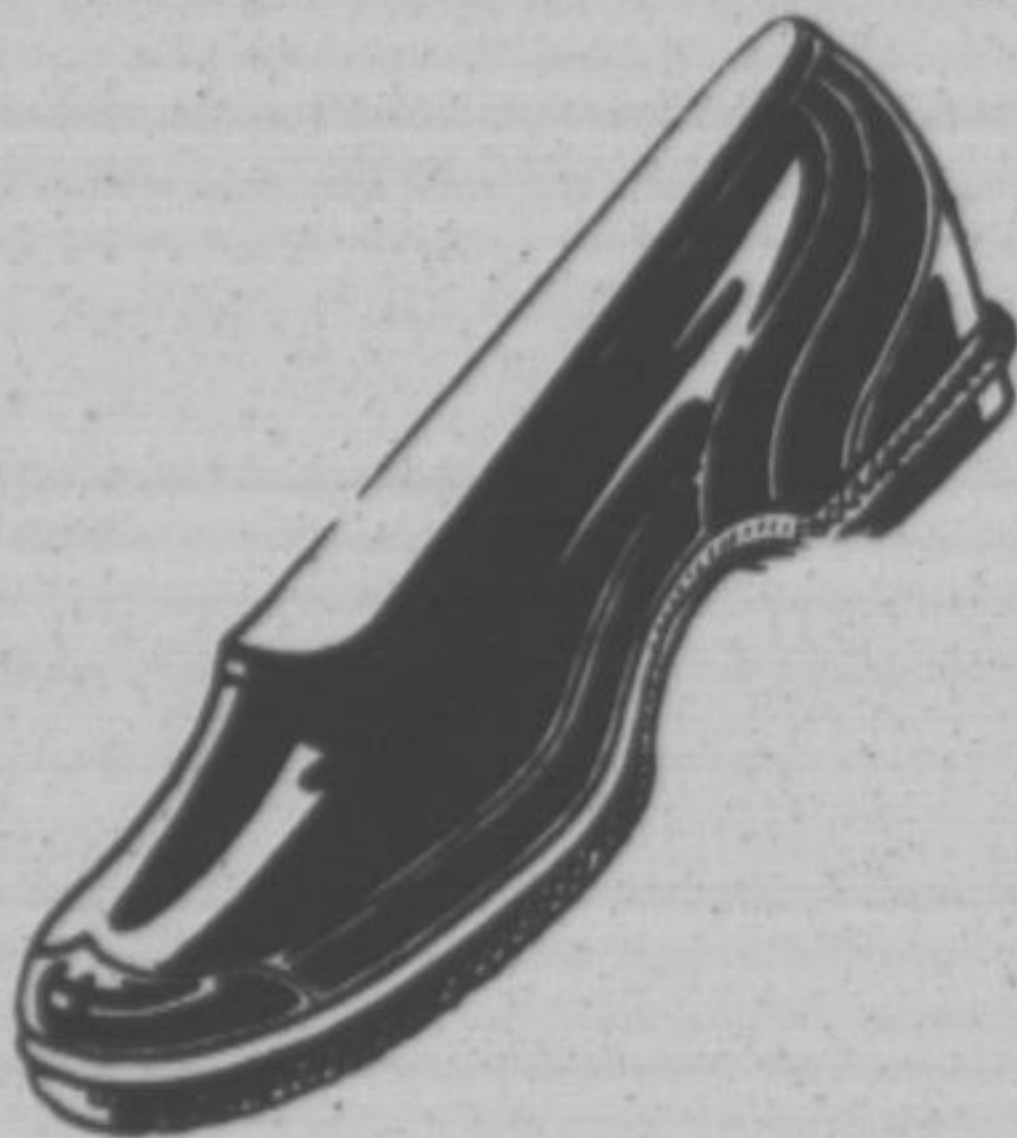

Last week 257 G. R's and Sunshiners met for their weekly meetings.

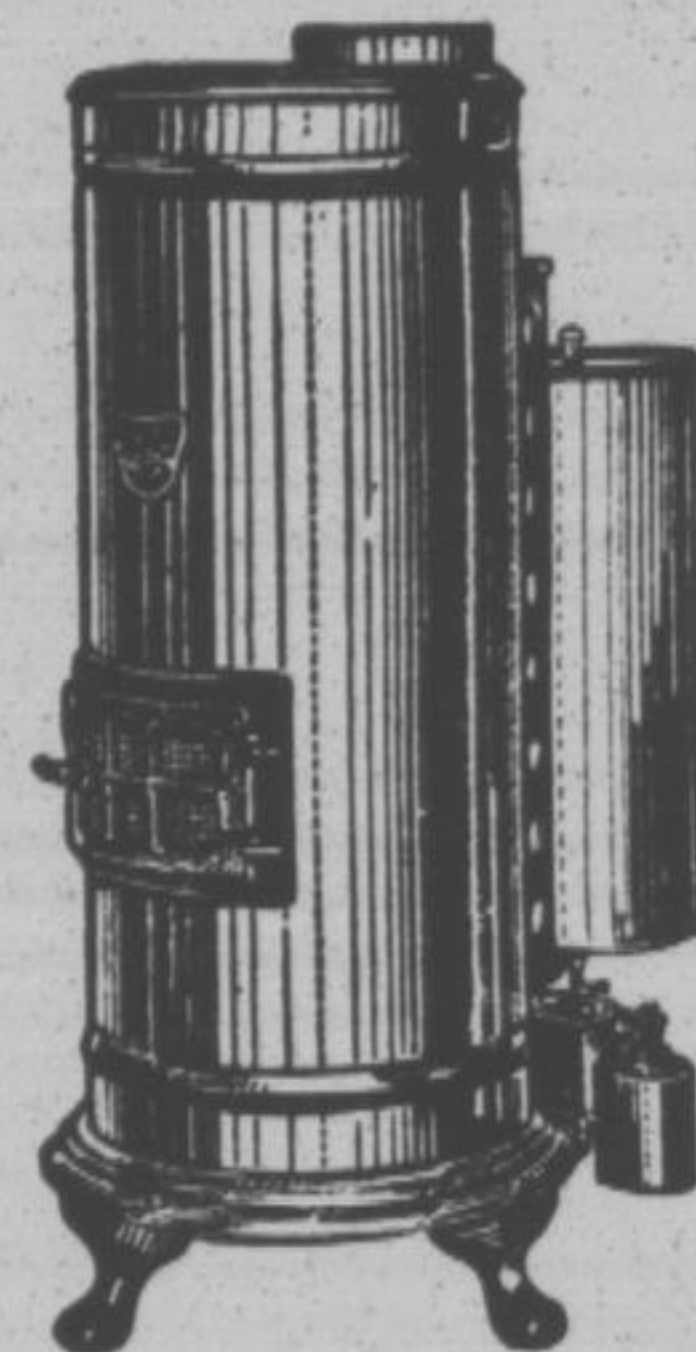
Leather work was started in the Rho Gamme Rho's G. R's group last meeting. 20 girls were present.
