### Estimates Lake County Share of State Gas Tax at \$135,000 to \$145,000

Estimating that Lake county's proportionate share of the state's 3 cent gasoline tax will be between \$135,000, and \$145,000 for 1930, R. M. Lobdell, county highway superintendents at returned from the convention of the county highway superintendents at Bloomington last week determined to fight for a change in the gas tax law.

Lobdell explained that under the present law, the funds are allocated to the various counties, but the funds are held in the state treasury until such a time as the county has actually expended the money.

Under the road bond issue passed by the county, the expenditures for road work in Lake county for 1930 will amount to about \$100,000 which will mean that a balance of \$35,000 or \$45,000 in Lake county funds will be held in the state treasury until the county must have the money for use here. Lobdell and other superintendents will ask that the funds be turned over to the county treasurer as soon as the funds are allocated.

At the meeting in Bloomington, Lobdell explained, a legislative committee was appointed and all county superintendents will make their recommendations for changes in the gas tax law to that committee.
