ORNATE STRUCTURE**

**Beautiful Building Being Erected in Wilmette by Religious Society; Details**

The Baha's temple at Wilmette, now under construction, has aroused so much interest in both the religious and architectural world that it has been made the subject of an article appearing in the Nov. 22 issue of the Literary Digest. The article, which quotes at length a description of the new temple by Allan B. McDaniel, which appears in The Technology Review, calls it "the first new idea in architecture since the 13th century." **Architectural Features**  
According to The Architectural Record, also quoted by the Digest, "the first story in its simplicity of line suggests the Greek and Egyptian temples; while the treatment of the doors and windows is Romanesque in form, and both Gothic and Arabic in the intricacy and beauty of ornamentation."
