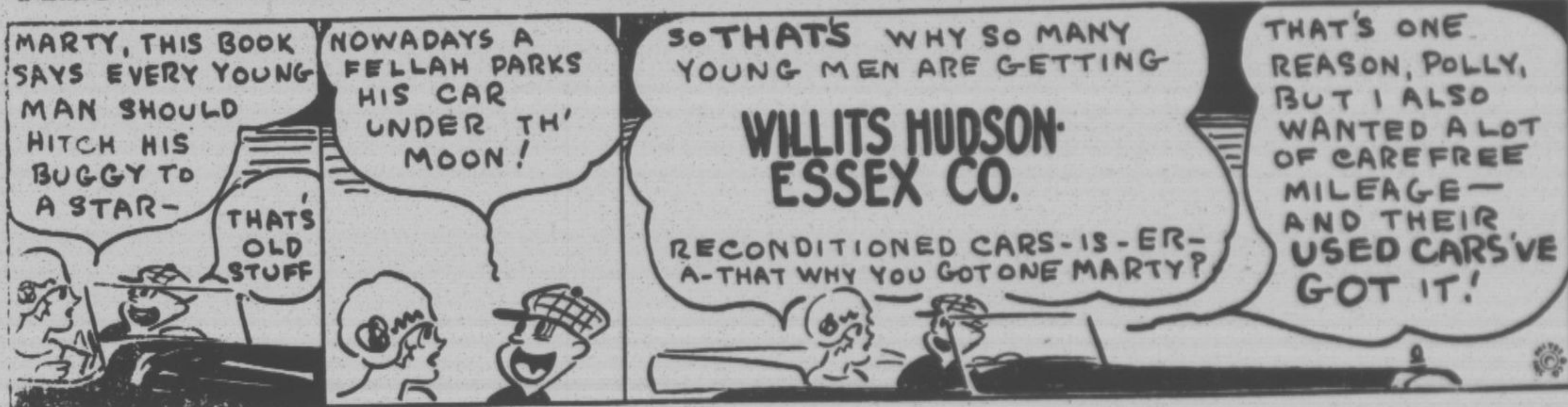

Directing Staff

The entire production is in the hands of Samuel S. Otis of Winnetka, director, who is assisted by John Allen Stewart, Evanston, business manager; Geneva Perry, Winnetka, costumes; Priscilla Guthrie, Winnetka, properties, and Charles Zoeckler, Evanston, technical director. The effects for the four acts and 10 scenes of the play are being constructed in the Circuit theatre studio in Evanston, Mr. Zoeckler being assisted there by volunteer, north shore helpers, and a crew from the University School of Speech.
