The estimated costs of the six plants was cutlined as follows: Win-\$736,000; North Chicago (enlargement), \$124,500; Lake Forest, (addition) \$47,000; Highwood (addition) \$93,500, and Highland Park, \$160,-000. The cost of the Waukegan plant represents more than twothirds of the total cost.
