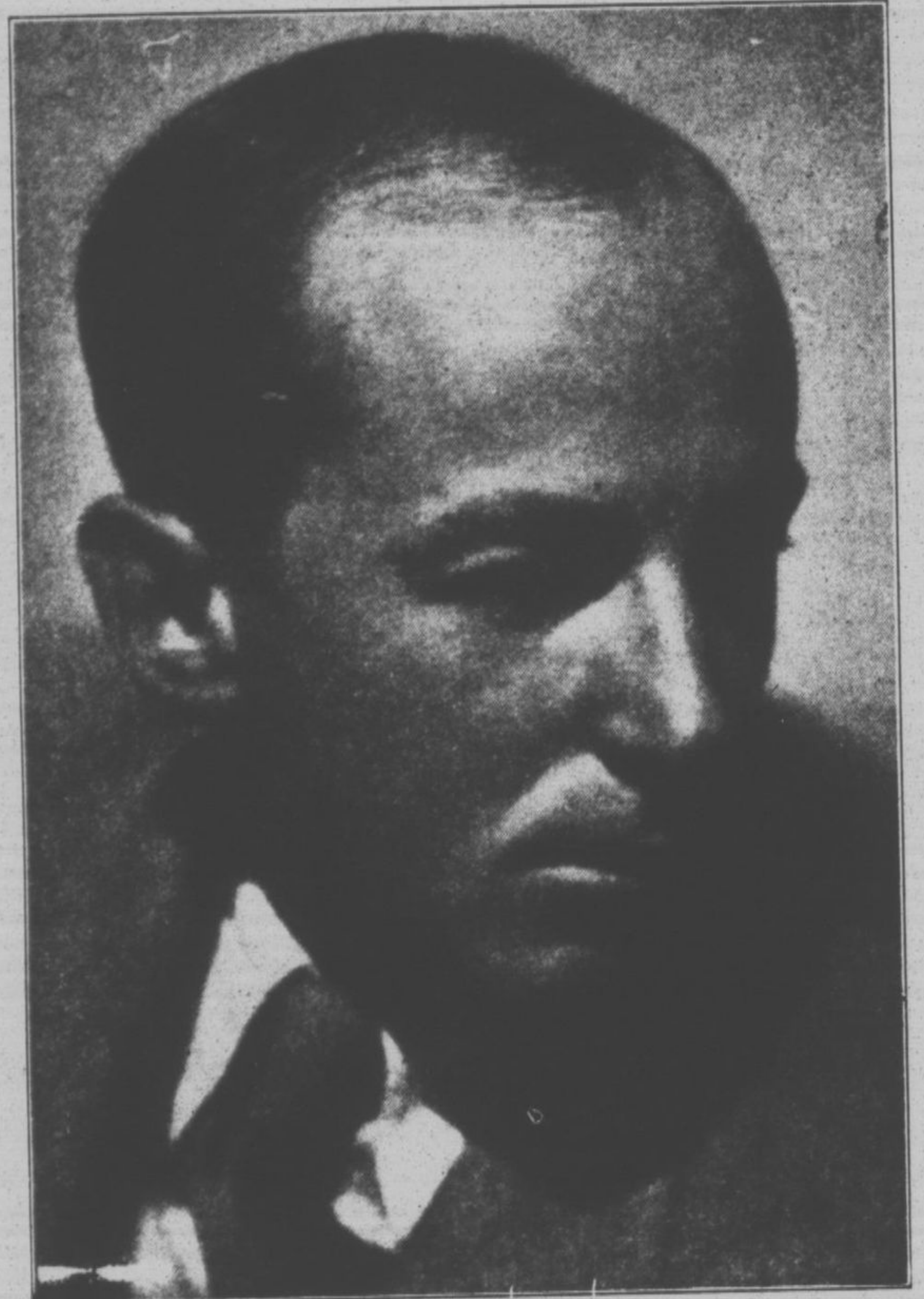

New Telephone Books Delivered on N. Shore

Delivery was started last week by the Illinois Bell Telephone company of about 15,000 telephone books for Waukegan, North Chicago and other north shore towns.

This year's supply of December books is on hand one month earlier than usual. The fact that Evanston went on the dial system the first of this month and had to have its new books at that time speeded up the delivery of the supply for the whole north shore. Usually the books do not come out until sometime in January.

Work for 25 persons will be provided by the company during the few days of distribution.

About 13,000 books containing local numbers—Waukegan, North Chicago, Great Lakes, Lake Bluff, Lake Forest and Highland Park—are to be distributed. They will be accompanied by about 1,500 Chicago telephone books for special places.
