2.—When you sit in your car with the windows closed are you sure all years. the exhaust connections are tight, and that no exhaust gas is leaking into the car?

3.—Are you sure that your gasstove is properly adjusted and that all the pipe connections, flexible hose and the meter are without leaks?

4.—Do all your gas burning devices have adequate flues propertly connected to a chimney?

5.—Do you burn a gas heater in your bathroom or other small confined space without proper circulation of air?

If you cannot answer all these questions with an emphatic "No" you may become an innocent victim of carbon monoxide poisoning, says a bulletin issued by Dr. W. J. R. Camp, pharmacology expert at the Chicago University College of Medicine.

Almost Odorless Gas

Carbon monoxide is a tasteless, colorless and almost odorless poisonous gas formed wherever carbon or coal is burned without an adequate supply of air. It is found in the exhaust gas of internal combustion gases to the extent of about 7 to 8 percent. It occurs in illuminating gas in large quantities—up to 30 per cent. It is for these reasons that over 50 people in Cook county during 1929 died from inhaling this gas. In 1916, there were 501 cases of carbon monoxide poisoning in Cook county hospital, or 8 percent of all coroner's cases.

If you will consider how little of this gas is necessary to kill a man, you will be more careful in the future. An engine rating about 25 hp. will deliver about 1.5 cubic feet of carbon monoxide a minute. In a small garage 10'x10'x20' a dangerous amount is reached in three minutes; in five minutes enough is present to suffocate a man; and in ten minutes there is a quantity sufficient to kill him.

And since this gas gives no warning except perhaps a headache or an attack of dizziness, many people die needlessly every year.
