

Old-Time Weapons Are Wanted for Exhibit on U. S. S. Constitution

The National Rifle association has announced that it had been asked by Rear Admiral Louis M. Nulton, U. S. N., to aid in the collection of old flintlocks and pistols to be placed in the arsenal of the U.S.S. Constitution.

Completion of five new cottages at the Chicago State hospital, at Dunning, was announced recently. This was one of the major projects in the \$10,500,000 building program sponsored by Gov. Louis L. Emmerson to relieve overcrowding at state institutions. The five buildings, having a capacity of 550 beds, will be sufficient only to permit patients who have been sleeping on floors, to receive a bed. Most of the 3,500 patients at Dunning are infirm or bedridden, and the department of public welfare in the near future intends to prohibit further commitments to the institution, excepting when beds become available.
