The Democratic candidate was Ed-California, and making, first, Gen. ward A. Hannegan and he was elected to the United States Senate by one vote, this ballot presumably being cast by the representative from De Kalb county who was elected by the one vote of his farmer friend. Senator Hannegan went to Washington. over the resolution declaring war on Mexico and for a long time with Senator Hannegan undecided on the resolution, the question of peace or war hung in the balance. Finally Senator Hannegan was induced to vote for the resolution and it was adopted by one vote, and war with Mexico was declared.
