AMENDING ORDINANCE FILED AND PASSED JUNE 30, 1922, APPROVED JULY 7, 1922 AND PUBLISHED JULY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of the Highland Park East Park District. Lake County, Illinois:

SECTION 1. That Section 6 of the Ordinance filed and passed June 30, 1922, approved July 7, 1922 and published July 13, 1922 be amended to read as follows:

"SECTION 6. No person chall kill, wound, or trap or attempt to kill, wound, or trap by use of fire arms, bow and arrow, pelting with stones or by means of traps or snares or any other devices or contrivances, any bird or animal within any of the parks or boulevards or other public places under the control of the Highland Park East Park District, or shoot an arrow or throw a stone or club or other missle at any bird og animal, or set a trap or snare for any bird or animal within any private ground near or abutting upon any of the parks or boulevards or other public places under the control of the Highland Park East Park District under a penalty of not less than Ten Dollars (\$10.00) nor more than Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) for each offense."

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication.

SECTION 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are and each of them is hereby expressly revealed.
