A saving of Illinois state funds totaling \$1,203,000 in 10 years will result from the transfer, during the past year, of 401 patients from state hospitals for the mentally afflicted to institutions in the states of which they are legal residents.

This computation, considered as conservative by officials of the state department of public welfare, is based on the average annual cost of caring for mental cases -\$300, for 10 years, the estimated average time the patients spend in Illinois state hospitals, multiplied by the number removed during the year-401.
