As Applicable to Special Assessments; To Petition County Board

Recommendations to the county board of supervisors for extension of time of collection of special assessments to July 1, drafted by Commissioner A. F. Carney, was approved by the Waukegan city council in meeting last week.

Commissioner Carney has proposed the plan as a means of saving many property owners from paying the penalty of 2 per cent for delinquent payment of assessments, and in order to lessen work and expense for both the city collection department and the county treasurer. The law providing that a penalty of 2 per cent be assessed against the property owner was approved at the last session of the state legislature.

Present System

Under the rule which has been in force for years special assessment records are turned over by the city to the county treasurer for collection on March 10. This has forced the city to stand the expense of billing the property owners, the county treasurer has received the books during the midst of his collection of general taxes adding to his work while the system as a whole has resulted in many delinquencies.

Prior to this year the city has been forced to pay the county treasurer 2 per cent for collection of the assessments. As \$525,000 in unpaid assessments were turned over to the county last year the city was penalized \$10,500. This in spite of the fact that the city was put to much expense in making out and mailing the thousands of bills.

Park and Lake Forest have agreed to co-operate and those of North Chicago, Zion, Libertyville and Mundelein are expected to aid in petitioning the board of supervisors.

Report Made on Fairs in State Last Year

County fairs of Illinois paid exhibitors and race horse owners \$526,-394.68 in premiums and speed prizes, according to a tabulation prepared from their annual reports to the department of agriculture. The consolidated statement shows that of the 60 fairs sharing in state appropriations four premimum reimbursement, 42 suffered financial losses aggregating \$96,431.41, and the other 17 gained, collectively, \$15,559.26. Treasuries of the expositions have been replenished from state funds to the extent of \$243,748.29, the balance in the biennial appropriation, after the distribution of \$276,251.71 to the reimbursements that totaled \$11,243,41 more than the balance of the fund.


