A complete file containing names and locations of the burial places of soldiers, sailors, marines, and nurses of Illinois who served in the World War has been compiled, and is for the first time available for use, says Mancel Talcott, Waukegan postmaster, and chairman of the state group of American Legion men by whom the work was done.

According to Talcott, the list contains approximately 25,000 names, which were gathered through the graves registration officers of the Legion posts throughout the state.

"With the recent publication of the 'Roll of Honor' in two volumes, the work of Brig. Gen. John J. Garrity, who is superintendent of the bureau and also a member of the graves registration committee, we hope to check
