

Hold Driver of Car Which Caused Death of Two Waukegan Men

James Wallace, driver of the automobile which crashed into Eric Turner's car Christmas day, fatally injuring Turner and Robert Brunson, was ordered held on manslaughter charges to await the action of the March grand jury by a coroner's jury following the inquest into the two deaths completed late last week.

Wallace was arrested when he left the Victory Memorial hospital, where Turner, a popular Waukegan business man, and Bronson, a butcher, died, and is now awaiting indictment on the manslaughter charge. State's Attorney A. V. Smith swore out a warrant for his arrest on this charge following Turner's death. Police Magistrate M. J. Haney of Waukegan, before whom Wallace appeared for preliminary examination, ordered him held to the grand jury, and set the bonds at \$7,000.

Besides Wallace, several witnesses of the tragic accident testified at the inquest, held under Dr. John Taylor.

Complete File of Soldiers' Graves Now Available Says Graves Officer

A complete file containing names and locations of the burial places of soldiers, sailors, marines, and nurses of Illinois who served in the World War has been compiled, and is for the first time available for use, says Mancel Talcott, Waukegan postmaster, and chairman of the state group of American Legion men by whom the work was done.

According to Talcott, the list contains approximately 25,000 names, which were gathered through the graves registration officers of the Legion posts throughout the state.

"With the recent publication of the 'Roll of Honor' in two volumes, the work of Brig. Gen. John J. Garrity, who is superintendent of the bureau and also a member of the graves registration committee, we hope to check

up with both the state records and Gen. Garrity's papers and get the exact data," he continued.

A Legionnaire has been appointed in every county in the state to make a survey, and have the grave of every war veteran recorded and decorated with flags and poppies on each Memorial Day.

Lists of this type are being compiled by the American Legion in each state in the union, the eventual aim being that the grave of each veteran shall be known and included in the roll.
