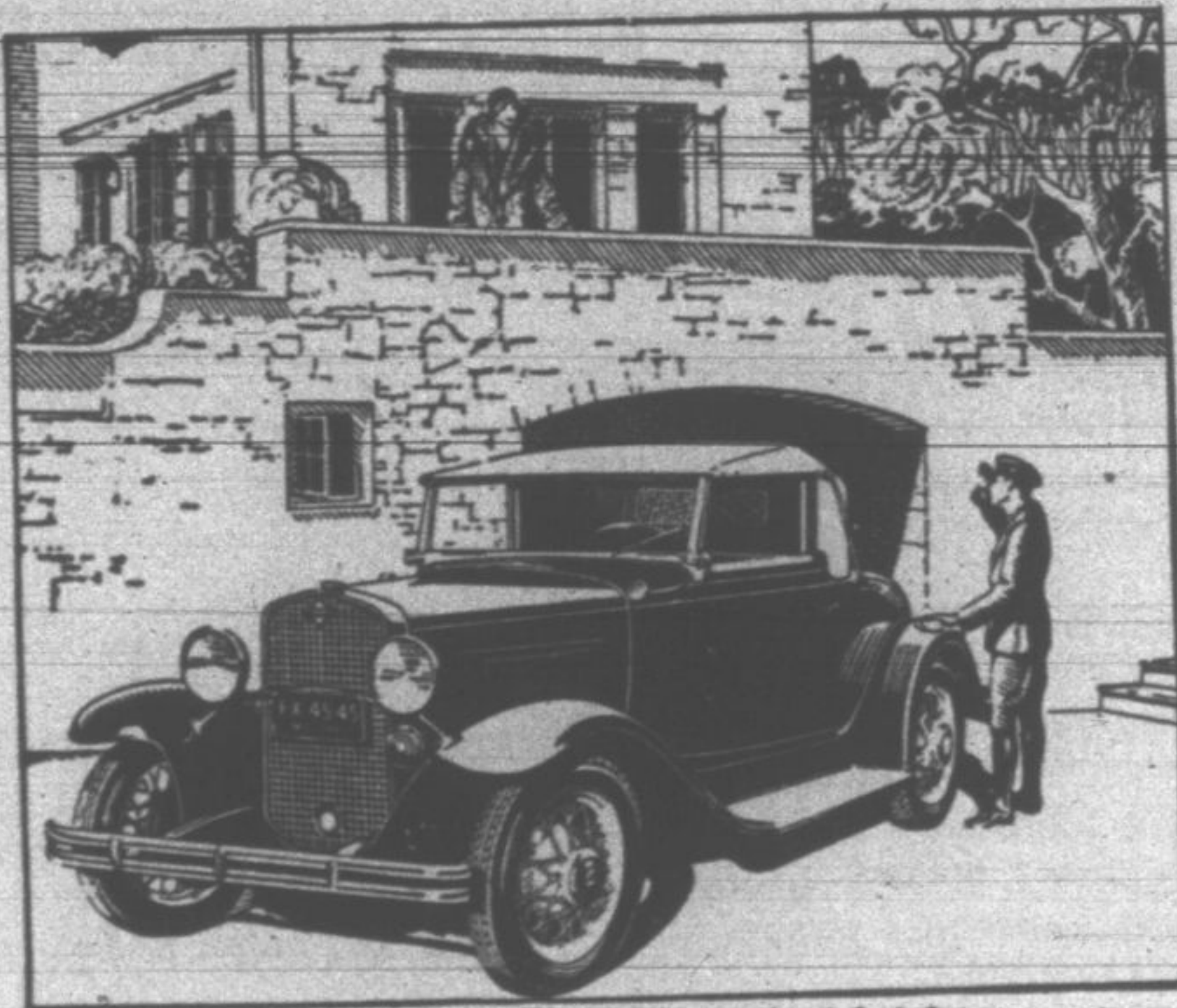

At this time the annual appeal is being launched in Lake county thru local appeal boards of representative citizens. The Rescue Home and Maternity hospital care for several from this county each year—the majority are free cases. Permanency of results in rehabilitation is the aim of the Army's training and care.

Mrs. Mary T. Wishman, appeal director of the Salvation Army for more than twelve years, and having intimate association with all of the sixteen major activities of the Home Service work is in charge of the appeal work this year. She will speak at the service clubs, Legion and Auxiliary, P. T. A. meetings and women's organization as given opportunity. She gives information of unusual interest quickly and effectively. Makes no appeal for funds, but has the responsibility of building local boards which will stand for the protection of the Salvation Army's interests in each town and also will discourage giving funds to promiscuous solicitors with a tambourine, dressed in some sort of uniform. It never reaches the Salvation Army Home Service and encourages getting money under false pretenses often times.
